





Dinosauria

Fabric by studio k Pattern Design by Karen DuMont 57" x 57"

MATERIALS

Yardages based on 42" wide unwashed fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

2-1/2 yds Dinosaur Scene (Y0913-8)

3/4 yd	Lt Lime Tonal (Y0914-17)
3/8 yd	Blue Leaves (Y0916-30)
1/2 yd	Blue Eggs (Y0918-30)
5/8 yd	Lt Blue Tonal (Y0914-29)
1/2 yd	Green Leaves Y0916-24)
5/8 yd	Dk Green Tonal (Y0914-25)

3-1/2 yds Backing of choice

CUT THE FABRICS

WOF = Width of Fabric LOF = Length of Fabric

From Dinosaur Scene "fussy" cut:

7 – 5-1/2" x WOF strips –border (fussy cut at same point of the repeat each time) 9 – 8-1/2" squares "on point" (Refer to picture of quilt as reference)

From Lt Lime Tonal cut:

2 – 11-1/4" squares (Block B) 7 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips (Inner Border) 36 – 1-1/2" squares

From Blue Leaves cut:

2 - 11-1/4" squares (Block B)

From Blue Eggs cut:

36 - 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Lt Blue Tonal cut:

2 – 15 -1/2" squares (setting triangles); cut twice on the diagonal to yield 8 setting triangles

2 – 8" squares (corner triangles); cut once on the diagonal to yield 4 corner triangles

From Green Leaves cut:

7 – 2" x WOF (inner border)

From Dk Green Tonal cut:

7 – 2-1/2" x WOF binding

DIRECTIONS

Block A (Dinosaur Scene block)

- 1. Referring to Diagram 1, sew a Blue Eggs 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to opposite sides of an 8-1/2" Dinosaur Scene square. (Make 9) Press seam out toward Blue Eggs.
- 2. Sew a 1-1/2" Lt Lime square to both ends of a Blue Eggs 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. (Make 18) Press seam to the Blue Eggs. Sew to opposite sides of the Dinosaur Scene square. Square block to measure 10-1/2".

Block B (Hourglass Block)

- 1. Using a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of two 11-1/4" Lt Lime Tonal squares. Place one of these squares on top of an 11-1/4" Blue Leaves square and sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press each side open; press the seam toward the dark. Repeat to make 4 half square triangle squares (Diagram 2).
- 2. Place one pieced square right sides together with a second pieced square, matching the seam lines and placing the dark half of one against the light half of the other. The seams should butt up against each other. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side perpendicular to the seam line (Diagram 3). Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press each seam open. Repeat to make a total of 4 Hourglass blocks; square blocks to measure 10-1/2" square.

Quilt Assembly


- 1. Refer to the quilt photo and arrange the blocks on a design wall. Place Block A's on point with three blocks across each row and three rows down. Place Block B's on point in between the Block A rows with two blocks across and two blocks down. Then place the side and corner –setting triangles.
- 2. Sew the blocks together in diagonal rows, being careful not to stretch the fabrics. Press the seams in each row in the opposite direction of the row above.
- 3. Sew the rows together. Trim off points to square up the quilt. It should measure approximately 42" square.

Borders

- 1. Sew the ends of (7) 1-1/2" x WOF Lt Lime Tonal strips together to make a long strip. Crosscut the long strip into (4) 1-1/2" x 64" Border 1 strips. In the same manner, make (4) 2" x 64" Green Leaves Border 2 strips and (4) 5-1/2" x 64" Dinosaur Scene Border 3 strips.
- 2. Sew (1) 2" x 64" Border 2 strip between (1) 1-1/2" x 64" Border 1 strip and (1) 5-1/2" x 64" Dinosaur Scene Border 3 strip to make a three strip border panel. Make 4 border panels. Press seams toward outer edge.
- 3. Mark the center of each border panel and each side of the quilt top. With right sides together, pin the border panels, matching the center marks, to each side of the quilt.
- 4. Sew the border panels to the quilt top, starting and stopping 1/4" from each corner. Press the borders out.
- 5. Lay quilt top, right side down. Lay one border over the other. Draw a straight line at a 45-degree angle from the inner to the outer corner as shown. Flip the positions of the borders and mark again from corner to corner.
- 6. Place the borders, right sides together with pencil lines carefully pinned together, and sew from the inner to the outer corner and backstitch. Open the seam; press and trim excess fabric.

Quilting and finishing

1. Piece the backing to measure 64" square. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Bind using the (7) 2-1/2" binding strips.
