

Finshed Quilt Size: 51" x 60 1/2" Finshed Block Size: 9 1/2"

Be sure to read through instructions before beginning. Cutting instructions include 1/4" seam allowance. Yardage is based on 42" of usable fabric width. All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) unless otherwise stated. Press all seams as you assemble your blocks. Border lengths given are exact measure ments. You may want to cut borders slightly longer to allow for variations in seams and mitering corners.

Fabric Requirements & Cutting Instructions:

1/3 yard

A.) (60) 2 1/8" square

Tonal Vine Pink 103.101.06

2/3 yard

B.) (60) 2 1/8" square

G.) (5) 2" x WOF

Paisley Green 103.101.07

1 1/2 yards

C.) (40) 2 1/8" x 3 3/4"

D.) (40) 2 1/8" x 6 7/8"

E.) (20) 5 3/4" square - cut diagonally once

Fairy Four Square Pink 103.101.01

1 yard

F.) (10) 7 1/4" square – fussy cut on point

Scallop Fence Border Pink 103.101.09 1 3/4 yards

H.) (2) 5" x 60" fussy cut strip

1.) (2) 5" x 50 1/2" fussy cut strip

Blossom Swirl Pink 103.101.02

1/2 yard

(5) 2 1/4" x WOF (binding)


Backing Fairy Toss Pink 103.101.04 3 yards

(2) WOF x 54"

Framed 4-Patch Block Assembly

Sew (2) A squares and (2) B squares together to make a 4-patch square. Sew (1) C strip to the right and (1) to the left of 4-patch. Repeat to make (10) sets (SET 1).


Sew (1) A square to the end of (1) C strip and (1) B square to the other end. Repeat to make (20) sets (SET 2).





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Referring to block diagram for color placement, sew (1) SET 2 to the top of SET 1 and (1) SET 2 to the bottom. Sew (1) D strip to the right and (1) to the left. Sew (1) SET 3 to the top of group and (1) SET 3 to the bottom.

Diamond in the Square Block Assembly

Sew the base of (1) C triangle to each side of (1) D fussy cut square to make the diamond in the square block. Repeat to make (10) blocks.



Quilt Assembly

Layout Framed 4-patch blocks and diamond in the square blocks in alternating every other one – (4) blocks per row, refer to quilt image for placement.

Sew blocks together to make five rows. Sew rows together to make quilt center.

Borders

Cut (1) G strip in half to make a length of 2" x 22". Sew (1) G strip and (1) half-G strip together end to end. Repeat. Matching centers, sew (1) G strip set to (1) H strip. Repeat to make a second G/H border set.

Matching centers, sew (1) G strip to (1) I strip. Repeat to make a second G/I border set.

Matching centers, pin in place and sew G/H border sets to sides of quilt, starting and stopping a generous 1/4" from each end of quilt.

Sew G/I border sets to top and bottom of quilt in the same manner. Be sure your smaller G border is always matched up to the edge of the guilt.

Miter all four corners.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting and backing piece, wrong sides of fabrics both toward batting and baste. Hand quilt, machine quilt or tie as desired. Sew binding strips together into one continuous strip, iron in half lengthwise and sew to raw edge of quilt top.
