Litter of Kittens

Please read all the instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric #1 - center designs evenly and cut 6 - "oval" blocks and 7 "days" blocks - 7" squares

Fabric #2 - A - cut 6 - 4 1/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 12 triangles.

D - cut 8 - 1 1/2" strips

E - cut 3 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 40 - 2 1/2" squares

Fabric #3 - C - cut 8 - 4 1/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 16 triangles.

F - cut 8 - 1 1/2" strips

G - cut 3 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 40 - 2 1/2" squares

Fabric #4 - B cut 7 - 5 1/8" squares

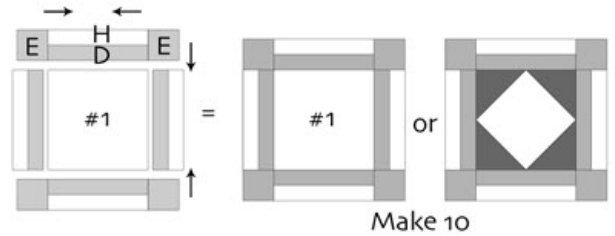
Outer Border - cut 6 - 5" strips, sew end to end and subcut 2 - 5" x 55" (SIDES) and 2 - 5" x 53 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM) borders.

Fabric #5 - Inner Border - cut 5 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end and subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 53" (SIDES) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM) borders.

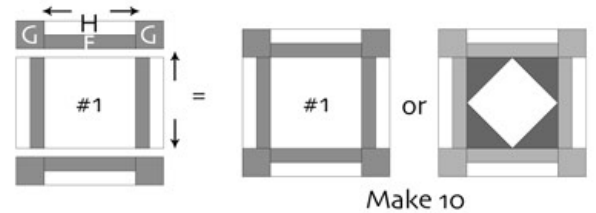
Binding - cut 7 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end, press in half.

Fabric #6 - BACKING - Piece backing approximately 5" larger than top.

Fabric #7 - H - cut 16 - 1 1/2" strips



Make 10 blocks by sewing F/H borders and G corner squares around center squares.



4. Sew blocks together by rows (alternating black and red borders) according to the diagram, then sew rows together.

Last, sew individual borders SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders. Baste layers together: backing, batting, and top. Quilt as desired.

2. Piecing Order:

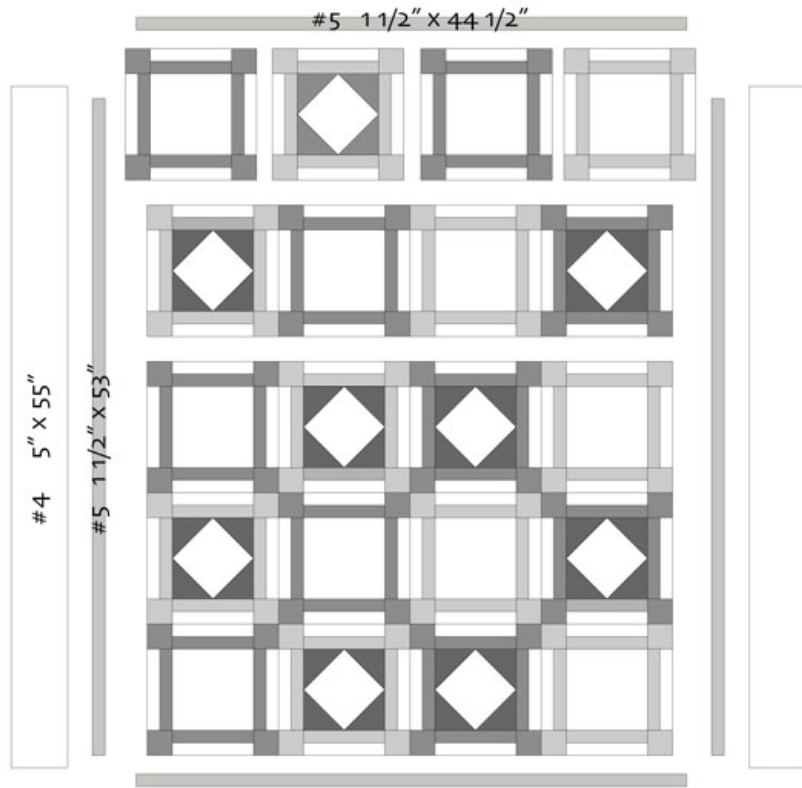
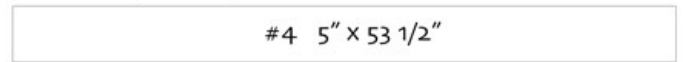
1. Make 7 Square in a Square blocks by sewing A or C triangles around B squares. Sew triangles to opposite sides first, press, then sew triangles to the remaining sides.



2. Sew 8 pairs of strips D/H and 8 pairs of strips F/H. Press to the dark (D or F). Subcut 40 - 7" segments from each combination.



3. Make 10 blocks by sewing D/H borders and E corner squares around center squares (ovals, days, or square in a square) according to the cover picture.



Quilt measures approximately 53" x 63 1/2" finished
