Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

1 yd	Women
1 yd	Heart Bursts - Pink
1-5/8 yd	Field of Hearts - White
7/8 yd	Tossed Hearts - Red (includes binding)
1/8 yd	Heart Vines - Red
3-1/2 yds.	backing of choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

Cutting:

From the Women fussy cut:

10 – 7-5/8" squares "on point", centering a different figure in each (see quilt)

From the Pink Heart Bursts cut:

5 – 11-1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally twice to make 20 triangles (2 extra) – (A)

2 – 11" squares, cut in half diagonally once to make 4 triangles – (B)

2 – 6-1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally once to make 4 triangles – (C)

From the White Field of Hearts cut:

12 – 7-1/2" squares

1 – 7-1/2" x WOF strip cut into:
12 – 7-1/2" x 2-1/4" rectangles

1 – 4-1/4" x WOF strip cut into:
4 – 4-1/4" x 7-1/2" rectangles

2 – 4" x WOF strips cut into:
24 – 4" x 2-1/4" rectangles

3 – 2-5/8" x WOF strips cut into:
48 – 2-5/8" squares, cut in half diagonally once – **Important:** cut 24 diagonally from the bottom left corner and cut 24 diagonally from the bottom right corner (hearts w/stems upright and fabric right side up)

1 – 1-3/4" x WOF strip cut into:
24 – 1-3/4" squares

From the Red Tossed Hearts cut:

12 – 1-3/4" squares

12 – 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles

4 – 1-3/4" x 40-1/2" sashing strips

2 – 1-3/4" x 35-1/2" sashing strips

6 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips - binding

From the Red Heart Vines cut:

12 – 1-3/4" squares

12 – 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles

Directions

Piece the Heart Block:

1. Sew a 1-3/4" Red Heart Vines square to a 1-3/4" White Field of Hearts square. Press seam toward the red. Sew a 1-3/4" x 3" Red Heart Vines rectangle to one long edge to make a "heart" square. Sew White Field of Hearts triangles to each edge, pressing toward the red after each seam. The stems should be vertical. (Figure 1) This square should measure 4". Repeat to make 12 heart squares with the Red Heart Vines squares and rectangles.
2. Substitute Red Tossed Hearts squares and rectangles for the Red Heart Vines pieces in Step 1 and make another 12 heart squares in the same manner.
3. Sew a White Field of Hearts 4" x 2-1/4" rectangle to the right side edge of each of the 12 squares from Step 1 above. Sew a rectangle to the left side edge of each of the 12 squares from Step 2 above.
4. Sew one heart each from Step 2 and Step 3 together to make 12 "heart" pairs.
5. Sew a 7-1/2" x 2-1/4" White Field of Hearts rectangle to the left side edge of each of the "heart" pairs from Step 4 above. The blocks should measure 7-1/2".

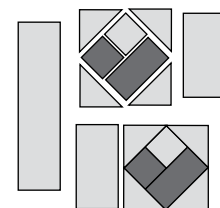

Construct the Quilt Center:

1. Layout the blocks of Women in a pleasing arrangement in vertical rows. Use the quilt image as a guide for suggested placement.
2. Sew triangles to the appropriate edges of the squares (Figure 2). Press seams toward the triangles.
3. Sew the units together on the diagonal, adding the triangles on the ends last, to make three vertical columns. Trim each column to 40-1/2" in length.
4. Sew a 40-1/2" red sashing strip to both edges of one of the outside rows. Press toward the sashing strips. Sew a strip to each of the other two columns on the proper edge (Figure 2). Sew the three columns together. Press.
5. Sew a 35-1/2" red sashing strip to the top and to the bottom. Press seams outward.

Add the Borders:

1. To make the side border sew three of the Heart Blocks alternately with two of the 7-1/2" square blocks. Add a 4-1/4" x 7-1/2" Field of Hearts rectangle to each end. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew to each side of the quilt center.
2. To make the top border, sew four 7-1/2" Field of Hearts squares alternately with three of the Heart Blocks. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew to the top and bottom edges to complete the quilt top.
3. Quilt as desired. Bind with the Red Tossed Hearts binding strips. Label the quilt to finish.

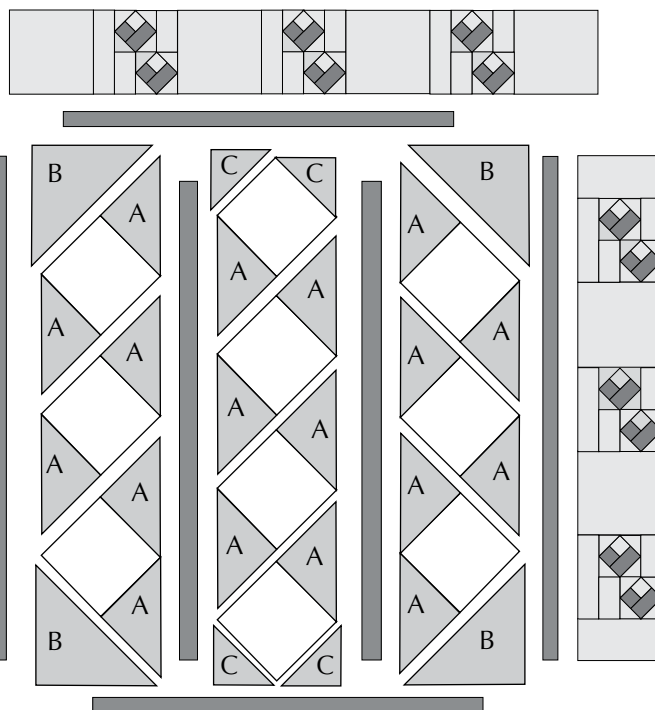
