## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide *unwashed* fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

- 1/4 Yd - Cream Floral Dot (Y0717-2)
- 1/4 Yd - Green Floral Dot (Y0717-23)
- 1/4 Yd - Pink Floral Dot (Y0717-42)
- 1/4 Yd - Cream Sm. Floral (Y0718-2)
- 1/4 Yd - Green Sm. Floral (Y0718-24)
- 1/4 Yd - Pink Sm. Floral (Y0718-42)
- 1/4 Yd - Green Lg. Floral (Y0719-23)
- 1/4 Yd - Pink Lg. Floral (Y0719-41)
- 1 Yd - Cream Tonal (Y0716-2)
- 1 1/2 Yd - Pink Floral Stripe (Y0715-41)
- 3/4 Yd - Red Tonal (Y0716-43)
- Inner Border/Binding
- 1 Yd - Cream Lg. Floral (Y0719-2)
- Outer Border
- 3 1/2 Yds - backing of your choice

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric  
LOF = Length of Fabric

**From each of the first 8 fabrics (Cream Floral Dot - Pink Lg. Floral) cut:**

- 3 - 7 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally twice to yield 12 geese triangles (only use 10 triangles of each fabric; set aside the 2 extra triangles)

**From the Cream Tonal cut:**

- 80 - 3 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally once to yield 160 background triangles

**From the Pink Floral Stripe cut:**

- 4 - 3 1/2" x 48 1/2" LOF strips

**From the Red Tonal cut:**

- 6 - 1 1/2" x WOF strips (Inner Border)
- 6 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips (Binding)

**From the Cream Lg. Floral cut:**

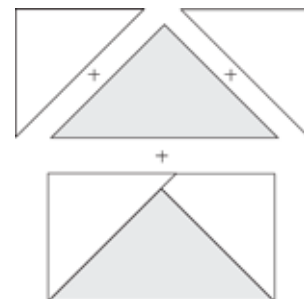
- 3 - 4 1/2" x WOF strips
- 3 - 6 1/2" x WOF strips

## Directions

### Flying Geese Blocks - Finished Size 6 1/2" square

1. Sew a 3 7/8" Cream Tonal triangle to each side of a 7 1/4" Geese triangle.
2. Sew 2 Geese units together to create a flying geese block.
3. Make 40 flying geese blocks. (Diagram 1)



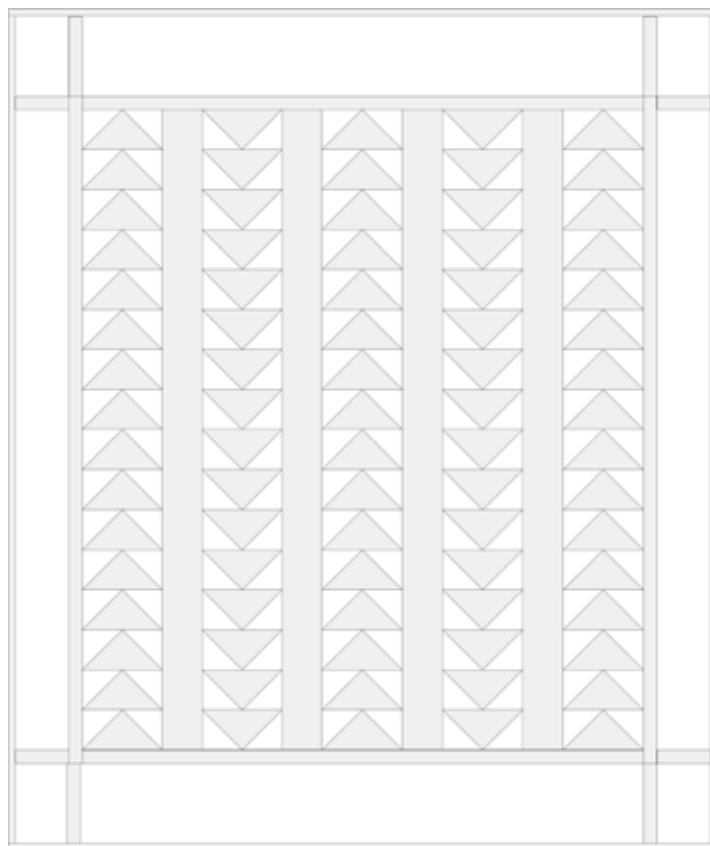

### Putting it Together

1. Sew 8 flying geese blocks together to create a vertical row.
2. Make 5 vertical rows.
3. Sew a 3 1/2" x 48 1/2" Pink Floral Stripe piece between each flying geese row to create the center of the quilt, reversing the direction of the geese in the 2nd & 4th rows.

### Borders

1. Sew the 1 1/2" Red Tonal WOF strips together lengthwise and cut into 2 - 48 1/2" strips, 2 - 52 1/2" strips, and 4 - 6 1/2" strips.
2. Sew the 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" Red Tonal strips to each side of the quilt center.
3. Sew the 4 1/2" Cream Lg. Floral WOF strips together lengthwise and cut into 2 - 48 1/2" strips.
4. Sew the 4 1/2" x 48 1/2" Cream Lg. Floral strips to each side of the quilt.
5. Sew the 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" Red Tonal strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.
6. Sew the 6 1/2" Cream Lg. Floral WOF strips together lengthwise and cut into 2 - 42 1/2" strips and 4 - 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
7. Sew a 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Red Tonal strip to each end of the 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" Cream Lg. Floral strip. Then sew a 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" Cream Lg. Floral rectangle to each end of the border unit. Make 2 outer border units.
8. Sew the outer border units to the top and bottom of the quilt. (Layout Diagram)

### Finishing

1. Layer quilt, batting & backing. Quilt and bind as desired.
