Happy Haunting

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated. The following instructions are for both door panels with Door Panel #2 in (), except **Fabric A** and **E** since they are used in both quilts and in the same position.

Door Panel #1 and #2 Instructions approximate size: $33\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " each

1. Cut the following:

Door Panel #1:

Fabric A - **cut 1 - $23\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric E - cut 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, subcut 16 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Fabric G - cut 4 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, subcut 12 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" and 4 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric H - Coping border - **cut 4 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{1}{2}$ "

Outer border - cut 5 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 " and 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34 "

Fabric I - BINDING - cut 5 - $2\frac{1}{4}$ " strips, sew end to end and press in half

Door Panel #2:

Fabric A - **cut 1 - $23\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric E - cut 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, subcut 16 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Fabric D - cut 4 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, subcut 12 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" and 4 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

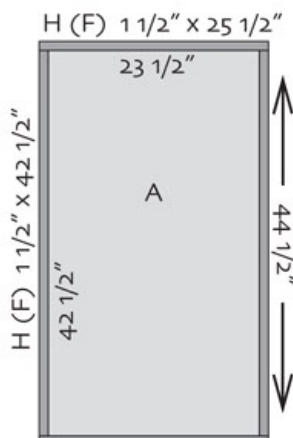
Fabric F - Coping border - **cut 4 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{1}{2}$ "

Outer border - cut 5 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 " and 2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34 "

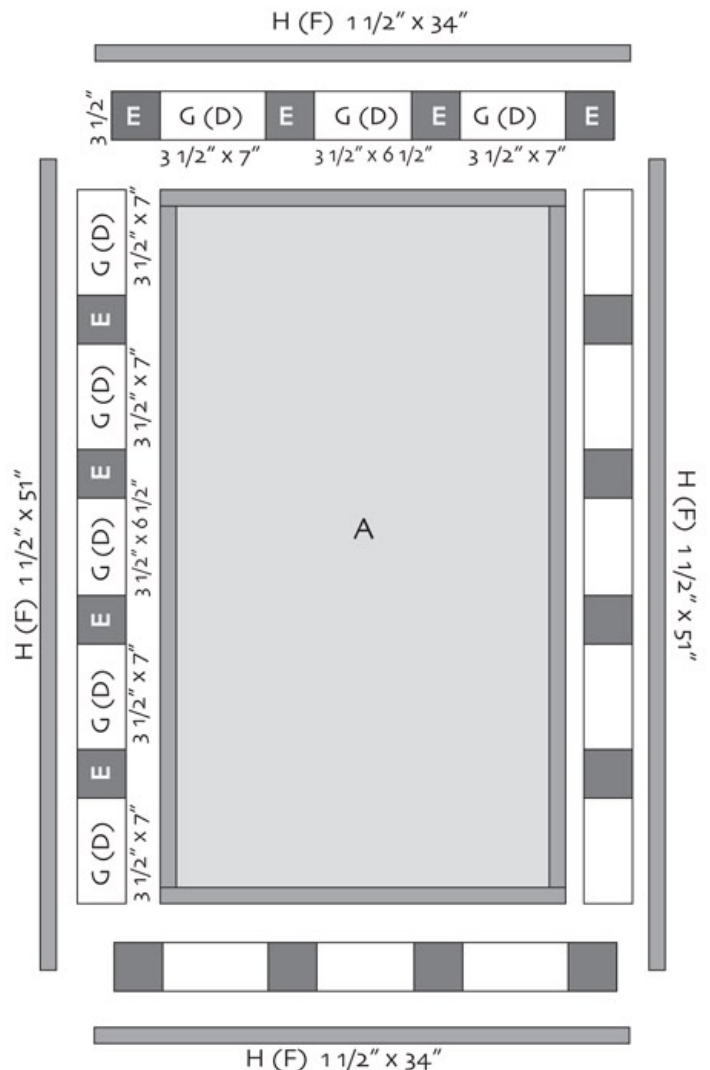
Fabric H - BINDING - cut 5 - $2\frac{1}{4}$ " strips, sew end to end and press in half

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **H (F)** $1\frac{1}{2}$ " borders around **A** $23\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " center panel, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders. ** (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **H** or **(F)** borders slightly larger, sew around **A**, then trim door panel center to measure $25\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " .)



2. Sew four **E** $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, four **G (D)** $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" rectangles and one **G (D)** $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle together for both SIDE borders according to the diagram. Sew four **E** $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, two **G (D)** $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" rectangles and one **G (D)** $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle together for both TOP and BOTTOM borders. Sew SIDE borders to the door panel center first, then sew TOP and BOTTOM borders.
3. Last, sew **H (F)** $1\frac{1}{2}$ " border around the quilt, SIDES first, TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagram.



4. The Door Panels measure approximately $33\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " Make backing, **Fabric G (C)**, at least 6" larger than the top. Layer and baste top, batting and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding, **Fabric I (H)**, and enjoy!!

The following instructions are for both Trick or Treat Bags with Bag #2 fabrics in (). Approximate size: 12" x 12" each. All strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

Bag # 1:

Fabric B - cut 2 border stripes lengthwise 11 1/2" wide by 13" length

Fabric G - Handles - cut 1 - 4 1/2" strip

Fabric H - Trim - cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 2 1/2" x 13"

Bag # 2:

Fabric D - cut 1 - 11 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 11 1/2" x 13"

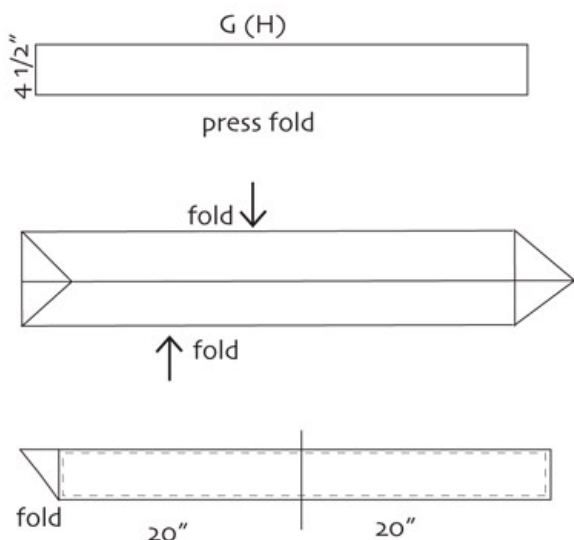
Fabric F - Trim - cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 2 1/2" x 13"

Fabric H - Handles - cut 1 - 4 1/2" strip

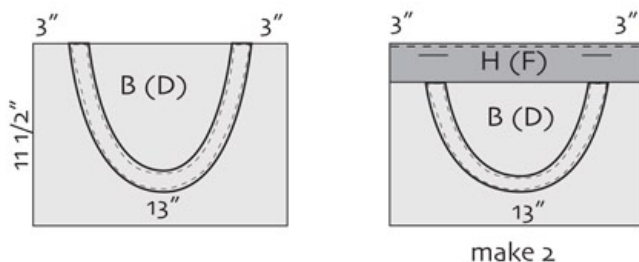
2. Piecing Order:

1. Make double folded handles by folding **G (H)** 4 1/2" strip in half and pressing fold. Next, open strip, with right sides out fold sides inward lining up side raw edges with pressed fold in the middle. Fold sides together for double folded handle.

Press. Topstitch both sides of handle. Cut handle in half for two handles approximately 1" x 20".

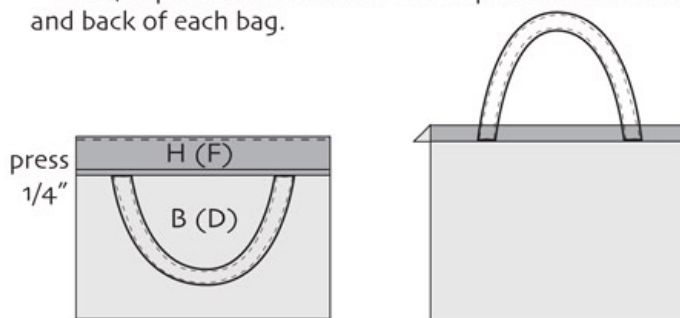


2. Place ends of handles **G (H)** over both **B (D)** pieces approximately 3" from sides according to the diagram. Next, place trim **H (F)** over **B (D)**, right sides together and matching top raw edge. Stitch top seam only. Handle ends may be double stitched for strength. Press toward **B (D)**



3. Press long side of trim **H (F)** 1/4" under, then fold trim over to cover seam. Topstitch folded trim over seam. Press.

Next, topstitch handles to trim. Repeat for both front and back of each bag.



4. Place two bag pieces together with right sides out. Stitch a scant 1/4" around the sides and bottom of the bag. Turn right sides in and take another seam along the sides and bottom to cover the first seam. Turn bag right sides out. Fill with candy and enjoy!
