MATERIALS

Yardage is based on 42" fabric width.

- ½ yard 7294-01 for house front
- ¼ yard 7289-01 for rain gutters and porch
- ⅓ yard 7295-02 for roofs
- ¼ yard 7292-01 and ¼ yard 7292-02 for folded roofs
- ¼ yard each of 7286-01, 7288-01, 7285-01, 7287-01 for shutters (optional)
- ⅜ yard 7295-04 for windows
- ½ yard 7293-01 for background
- 1⅛ yards 7284-01 for inner border
- ⅝ yard 7295-02 for outer border
- 1 yard 7291-02 for folded outer border triangles
- ¼ yards 7290-01 for backing
- ⅓ yard 7293-04 for binding
- 41" x 44" batting
- ¼ yard for hanging sleeve
- 8 clasps (½" x ¾") for shutters (optional)
- Orange #8 perle cotton thread
- Black #8 perle cotton thread

CUTTING

Always remove selvages.

7294-01

Cut 2 strips 5" x fabric width. From this strip, cut in the following order:

- 1 strip 5" x 25¼" for A.
- 5 rectangles 3½" x 5" for B.
- 2 rectangles 2" x 5" for C.
- 1 strip 1¼" x 5" for D.
- 1 strip 4¼" x 12½" for E.
- 1 strip 2" x 13¼" for F.
- 1 strip 2" x 12½" for G.
- 1 strip 2" x 12½" for H.

7289-01

Cut 1 strip 1¼" x fabric width. From this strip, cut:

- 1 strip 1¼" x 25¼" for I.
- 1 strip 1¼" x 12½" for J.

Cut 1 strip 1½" x fabric width for porch. (You will trim to size later.)

7295-02

Cut 1 strip 5" x fabric width. From this strip, cut:

- 3 rectangles 3½" x 5" for K.
- 1 rectangle 3½" x 5¾" for L.
- 1 strip 2¾" x 13¼" for M.
- 1 strip 1¼" x 13¼" for N.
- 1 strip 2¾" x 12½" for O.
- 1 strip 1¼" x 12½" for P.

7292-01 AND 7292-02

Cut 6 squares 4½" x 4½" from 7292-01 and 2 squares 4½" x 4½" of 7292-02 for Double-Folded Triangles to make 8 roofs.

7295-04

Cut:

2 squares $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ for dormer windows.

6 rectangles $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$ for house windows.

MISC. PRINTS FOR SHUTTERS (OPTIONAL)

Cut 1 strip $5\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ fabric width of each fabric for shutters.

Follow the instructions for making Pleated Shutters.

Trim 12 of the shutters to $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5''$ and 4 of the shutters to $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$.

7293-01

Cut:

3 rectangles $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ for Q.

1 rectangle $11'' \times 13\frac{1}{4}''$ for R.

3 strips $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times$ fabric width for background border.

(You will trim to size later.)

7284-01

Cut 4 strips $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times$ fabric length for inner border.

(You will trim to size later.)

7295-02

Cut 4 strips $4'' \times$ fabric width for outer border.

(You will trim to size later.)

7291-02

Cut 6 strips $5'' \times$ fabric width then cut each strip into $5'' \times 5''$ squares for the Double-Folded Triangles for outer border.

BINDING

Cut 5 strips $2'' \times$ fabric width.

HANGING SLEEVE

Cut 1 strip $8'' \times$ fabric width. (You will trim to size later.)

FOLDED UNITS

Make 8 Double-Folded Triangles for the roofs using Folding Techniques pg 4.

Make 42 Double-Folded Triangles for the border using Folding Techniques pg 4.


Make 16 Pleated Shutters using Pleated Shutters, pg 6.

CONSTRUCTION


Use $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam allowance. Press away from the folded units.

QUILT TOP

1. Place 2 shutters on top of the corresponding window fabric pieces. Baste $\frac{1}{8}''$ from the raw edges of the shutter. Repeat for remaining shutters.
2. Arrange the sections and folded units as shown in the Quilt construction illustration.
3. Stitch the blocks into rows and then sections, inserting the folded units. Press.
4. Place a rectangle Q on the left side of dormer section, right sides together. Stitch at a diagonal. Trim and press. Repeat for the remaining Q pieces.



5. Stitch the sections together. Press.
6. Trim the $1\frac{1}{2}''$ 7289-01 strip to $25\frac{1}{4}''$. Stitch it to the bottom of the quilt top for the porch. Press.
7. Trim 1 of the $1\frac{1}{2}''$ 7293-01 strips to $25\frac{1}{4}''$. Stitch it to the top of the quilt top for the background border. Press.
8. Trim the remaining $1\frac{1}{2}''$ 7293-01 strips to $30\frac{1}{4}''$. Stitch them to the sides of the quilt top for the background border. Press.



Quilt construction

BORDERS

Your top should measure $27\frac{1}{4}'' \times 30\frac{1}{4}''$. If it does, follow the instructions below and trim the border strips to the lengths specified. If it doesn't, measure and trim the border strips to fit your top.

1. Trim 2 of the inner border strips to $30\frac{1}{4}''$. Stitch them to the sides of the quilt top. Press.
2. Trim the other 2 inner border strips to $29\frac{3}{4}''$. Stitch them to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press.
3. Trim 2 of the outer border strips to $32\frac{3}{4}''$. Stitch them to the sides of the quilt top. Press.
4. Trim the other 2 outer border strips to $36\frac{3}{4}''$. Stitch them to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press.
5. Place 10 overlapping Double-Folded Triangles on the top edge of the quilt top. Baste $\frac{1}{8}''$ from the edge. Repeat along the bottom edge.
6. Place 11 overlapping Double-Folded Triangles on 1 side edge of the quilt top. Baste $\frac{1}{8}''$ from the edge. Repeat along the other side.

FINISHING

QUILTING

1. Layer and baste.
2. Stitch in-the-ditch around the blocks.

FINISHING TOUCHES

1. Add Double-Fold Straight-Grain Binding.
2. Add a hanging sleeve.
3. Be sure to add a label to your Halloween heirloom.

EMBELLISHING

1. With perle cotton thread, hand stitch around the shutters, and roofs, taking care to keep them dimensional.
2. Tack pleats on the shutters.
3. Sew on the shutter clasps.


FOLDING TECHNIQUES

DOUBLE-FOLDED TRIANGLES


1. Cut a square the size specified in the project instructions.




2. Fold in half horizontally, right sides together, and press.




3. Open the square wrong side up. Grasp each end of the crease.



4. Bring A and B down to meet at C.



5. Press.



6. Bring the top corner from each side down so the folds meet at the center of the triangle. Press.




7. Trim.



PLEATED SHUTTERS

1. Cut a strip $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x fabric width and trim off selvages. On the right side of the fabric, draw a line 2" from the end, then $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", $2\frac{1}{2}$ ", $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", repeating the pattern to the end of the strip.




2. With wrong sides together, align the first 2 lines and pin. Repeat for the entire length.




3. Stitch on the marked/pinned lines. Press the pleats flat, centering them over the seamlines.



4. Cut shutters apart $3\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, centering the pleats. Trim the longer shutters to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" and the shorter shutters to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".



5. Fold in half vertically, right sides together, and stitch along the top and bottom edges, using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.



6. Turn right side out and press.
