Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide *unwashed* fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric LOF = Length of Fabric

From Cream Main Print cut:

1 - 24-1/2" w x 20-1/2" h rectangle

From Black/Black Skulls cut:

1 – Cat and 3 Bats appliqués (see instructions – Assemble the Quilt Steps 2 thru 4)

4 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips; sew end to end and press in half lengthwise (binding)

From Black Main Print cut:

4 – 6-1/2" squares

8 – 2" (cut LOF) x 6-1/2" rectangles

From Stripe cut:

2 - 6-1/2" (cut WOF) x 20-1/2" rectangles -borders

From Orange Tonal cut:

4 – 2" (cut LOF) x 6-1/2" rectangles 1 – Large pumpkin appliqué (see instructions – Assemble the Quilt Steps 2 thru 4)

From Lime Skulls, Black/White Skulls, Purple Words, Gold Tonal and Purple Tonal cut:

4 - 2'' (cut LOF) x 6-1/2" rectangles

Directions



Upper and Lower Borders:

- 1. Sew 2" x 6-1/2" strips in pairs, making four of each combination (see quilt image for placement and orientation): Lime Skulls with Black Main, Purple Words with Gold Tonal, Black/ White Skulls with Orange Tonal, Black Main with Purple Tonal.
- 2. Sew eight pairs of strips together to make upper and lower borders.
- 3. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

Assemble the Quilt:

- 1. Sew a 6-1/2" Black Main Print square to each end of a 6-1/2" x 20-1/2" Stripe border strip. Repeat to make two borders. Sew to the left and right edges of the quilt center.
- 2. Trace the appliqué images onto the paper backing of the fusible web. Cut them out approximately 1/2" outside the outlines of the figures.
- Following manufacturer's instructions, lightly iron the cat and bat shapes to the back of the Black Skulls fabric. Lightly iron the pumpkin to the Orange Tonal. Cut out the figures on the lines. Remove the paper backing.
- 4. Arrange the figures on the center square, using the quilt image as a reference and iron them in place (follow manufacturer's instructions).
- 5. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing; baste and quilt as desired. Bind and label to finish.



Enlarge appliqué images 400%. Images are reversed for fusible appliqué.
