FINISHED SIZE: 50" x 63-1/2"





	D	Paisley 4461-11 <i>Red</i>	1/3YD	 (4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Recut into: (6) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips. (6) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips.
	E	Holly 4466-44 <i>Green</i>	1/4YD	(6) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.
	F	Holly 4466-33 <i>Gold</i>	1/4YD	(6) 4-1/2" squares.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY Quilt consists of two blocks.



BLOCK ONE: Cut (6) 8-1/2" squares of **A** Silhouettes from panel as shown on left diagram. Add **E** and **B** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips to BLOCK **A**; sew **E** to top and **B** to bottom. Next add **C** and **D** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips to sides of BLOCK **A**; sew **C** to left and **D** to right. Your block should measure 12-1/2". Make 6 blocks. Set aside.




BLOCK Two: Add log cabin strips around 4-1/2" **F** square clock wise as shown on left diagram. Your block should measure 12-1/2". Make 6 blocks.

Please Note: Layout all your blocks before sewing rows together; rotating BLOCK Two in a pleasing design.

ROW ASSEMBLY Quilt consists of four rows.


Row One and Three: Add K 2" x 12-1/2" sashing strips to sides of (2) Block Ones (bear and wolf), see diagram below. Then sew Bear Block to Block Two and Block Two to Wolf Block. Use Moose and Deer sillouettes for Row Three.



Row Two and Four: Similar to previous step, using Block One as middle block. Add **K** 2" x 12-1/2" sashing strips to sides of (2) Block Twos. Then sew Block Two to Block One (geese) and Block One to remaining Block Two. For Row Four use birds sillouette. See quilt diagram below for reference.

Next sew K sashing strips (2" x 42-1/2") to top and bottom of Row One and to bottoms of Rows 2-4. Then sew Row One to Row Two and so forth. Follow quilt diagram below.

Outer Border: Measure length of quilt top (shoud be about 55-1/2") and cut (2) $\bf L$ strips to size. Sew strips to sides. Repeat for width of quilt top (should be about 50"). Cut $\bf L$ strips to size and sew to top and bottom of quilt top.



FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner. Finished Size: 50" x 63-1/2"
