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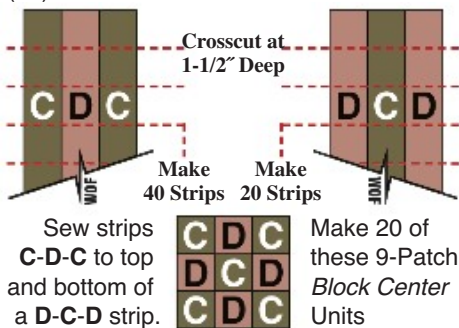
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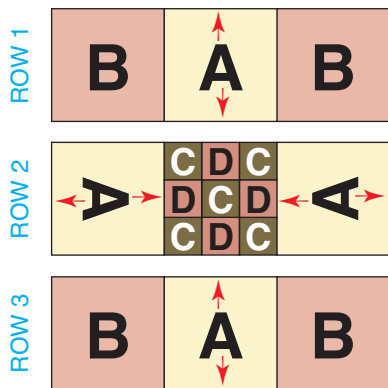
Continually refer to photo
1/4" seam allowance has been added to sizes.

ASSEMBLY

9-Patch Block Centers: Sew (2) 1-1/2" C strips to each side of a D strip. Press and crosscut (40) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" C-D-C units. Then sew (2) 1-1/2" D strips to each side of a C strip. Press and crosscut (20) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" D-C-D units.



BLOCK ONE: Sew together A and B 3-1/2" squares as shown below with the Block Center in Row 2. Note direction of stripes → for the A squares. Sew Rows together. Make 10 Blocks.



Flying Geese Units: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 2 G squares. Place the squares on top of a H 3-1/2" square, right sides together on opposite corners. Corners of G squares overlap at center. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.



Place another G square on top, right sides together to match the corners. Again, stitch 1/4" on each side of drawn line, cut on drawn line, open and press.



Repeat until you have made 80 units.

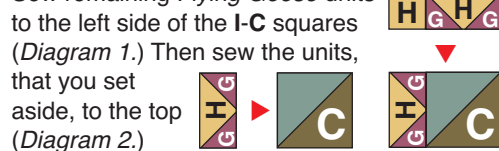
BLOCK TWO: Sew a 1-1/2" H square to left side of each of the 40 Flying Geese units. Set aside.

A		Sweet Buds 3522-33 Flax	3/4 YD	(7) 3-1/2" x WOF* strips. Subcut (80) 3-1/2" squares.
B		Meadow Lark 3519-26 Tea Rose	1/2 YD	(4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 3-1/2" squares.
C		Fern Field 3518-49 Deep Olive	1-1/2 YDS	(3) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. (2) 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (18) 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" rectangles. (2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (20) 2-7/8" squares. (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.
D		Fern Field 3518-26 Tea Rose	1/4 YD	(3) 1-1/2" x WOF strips.
E		Woodland Blooms 3517-33 Flax	5/8 YD	(2) 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (6) 5" x 9-1/2" rectangles. (8) 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" rectangles.
F		Meadow Lark 3519-50 Blue Sky	5/8 YD	(2) 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (7) 5" x 9-1/2" rectangles and (10) 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" rectangles.
G		Fern Field 3518-66 Berry	1/3 YD	(4) 1-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (80) 1-7/8" squares.
H		Berry Bramble 3521-33 Flax	1/3 YD	(2) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 1-1/2" squares. (2) 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (20) 3-1/4" squares.
I		Berry Bramble 3521-50 Blue Sky	1/4 YD	(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut (20) 2-7/8" squares.
J		Florabunda Panel 3515-33 Blue Multi	1 YD	Fussycut (16) 5" squares.
K		Flora & Fauna Garland 3516-33 Blue Multi	2 YDS	(4) strips lengthwise 5" x 72". These are to be fussycut over the blue scroll of the border.

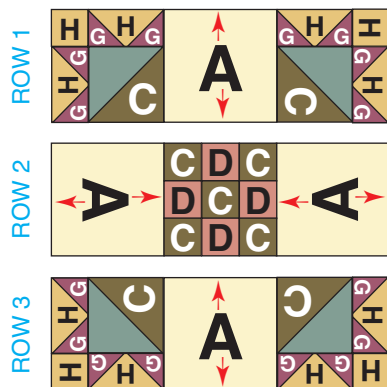
*Width of Fabric

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all (20) 2-7/8" I squares. Then place each right sides down on all, right sides up, (20) 2-7/8" C squares. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line, cut on drawn line and press open.

Sew remaining Flying Geese units



to the left side of the I-C squares (Diagram 1.) Then sew the units, that you set aside, to the top (Diagram 2.) Sew 4 of these units to the sides of (2) 3-1/2" A squares, as shown below, noting the orientation. Also note direction of stripes → for the A squares. Then sew (2) 3-1/2" A squares to the sides of a Block Center for Row 2. Sew rows together. Make 10 Blocks.



Referring to photo, sew all (18) 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" C rectangles to the corresponding E and F

rectangles. Set aside. Then sew blocks and vertical sashing in this order (see photo):

- Row 1 Block Two > C-E sashing strip;
- 1 Block One > 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" E rectangle;
- Block One > C-E sashing strip (flipped);
- Block Two.
- Rows 2-4 Block One > C-F sashing strip;
- 2-4 Block Two > 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" F rectangle;
- Block Two > C-F sashing strip (flipped);
- Block One.
- Row 5 Repeat steps in Row 1.

HORIZONTAL SASHING: Make 2 sets. For the first set, sew C-E, C-F rectangle units to 5" J squares in this order:



For the second set, reverse order of strips:



Following the diagram below, make 2 sets of horizontal sashing:



Continue in this manner, using block and sashing placement shown in photo. After rows are sewn together, sew rows 1-5 together.

BORDERS: Cut (2) 63-1/2" long K strips and sew to sides of quilt. Cut (2) 50" long K strips, attach a J panel square to each end and sew to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind using 2-1/2" C strips.
