Fabrics by The Quilt Patch
Pattern Design by The Quilt Patch 60" x 70"

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Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide unwashed fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

One fat eighth of each:

Y0887-3 – Black Star Flowers
 Y0887-4 – Red Star Flowers
 Y0884-3 – Black Multi Dots
 Y0884-14 – Brown Dots
 Y0884-4 – Red Dots
 Y0884-24 – Green Dots
 Y0889-15 – Brown Daisy Toss
 Y0888-15 – Brown Daisy Trio

One fat quarter of each:

Y0888-24 – Green Daisy Trio
 Y0888-4 – Red Daisy Trio

1/2 yard - Y0885-12 – Khaki Star Vine
 1 yard - Y0885-3 – Black Star Vine
 5/8 yard - Y0889-12 – Khaki Daisy Toss
 3/4 yard - Y0889-4 – Red Daisy Toss
 2 yards - Y0886-3 - Black Daisy Baskets
 4 yds - Backing Fabric of choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From each of the 8 fat eighths cut:

2 – 5-7/8" squares; cut each in half diagonally to yield 32 triangles

From each of the 2 fat quarters cut:

4 – 5-7/8" squares; cut each in half diagonally to yield 16 triangles

From Khaki Star Vine cut:

12 – 6-1/4" squares; cut each in half diagonally twice to yield 48 triangles

From Black Star Vine cut:

12 – 6-1/4" squares; cut each in half diagonally twice to yield 48 triangles
 6 – 3" x WOF strips

From Khaki Daisy Toss cut:

6 – 3" x WOF strips

From Red Daisy Toss cut:

4 – 3" x WOF strips
 6 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips

From Black Daisy Baskets cut in the following order:

2 – 6-1/2" x WOF strips
 2 – 6-1/2" x length of fabric – trim to measure 6-1/2" x 57-1/2"
 2 – 6-1/2" x WOF (approx. 27") strips
 7 – 2-1/2" x length of fabric – set aside for binding

Directions

Make the Blocks:

For each block:

1. Use 4 Khaki Star Vine and 4 Black Star Vine triangles and 4 print triangles.
2. Sew a black and a khaki triangle together, using Diagram 1 as a guide. Press the seam towards the black. Make 4.
3. Sew a print triangle to the long side of the black/khaki unit – see Diagram 2. Press the seam towards the print triangle. Make 4.
4. Lay out the four sections as your block will appear finished. Sew two sections together. Press the seam towards the print triangle. Repeat with the remaining two sections.
5. Sew the two rows together. See diagram 3. Pressing the seam open will help the block to lay flat.
 Make 12 blocks – 10-1/2" x 10-1/2"

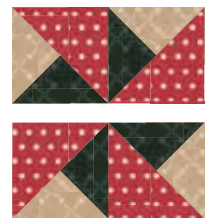

Putting the quilt together:

1. Lay out the twelve blocks into 4 rows, with 3 blocks in each row. Sew the blocks together to make the rows. Press the seams open. Sew the rows together to make the quilt center.
2. From the Red Daisy Toss 3" strips cut:
 2 strips – 3" x 40-1/2" – sew these strips to the sides of the quilt
 2 strips – 3" x 35-1/2" – sew these to the top and bottom of the quilt.
3. Press seams toward the red border.

Checkerboard border:

1. Sew a black 3" x WOF strip to a khaki 3" x WOF strip along the long edge. Press toward the black. Repeat to make 6 strip sets. Cross-cut each strip set into 3" segments for a total of 72. See Diagram 4.
2. Alternating the segments, sew 18 together to make a row. Press. Make another. Sew one to each side of the quilt, using Diagram 5 as a guide for placement. Press seam allowance toward the red border.
3. Alternating segments, make 2 more sets of 18 segments each and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt, using diagram #5 as a guide for placement.
4. Sew six Red Daisy Toss 1-1/2" x WOF strips together end to end to make one long continuous strip. From this strip cut: 2 strips – 1-1/2" x 55-1/2" for the outer border on each side of the quilt. Stitch, press toward the border. Cut 2 strips – 1-1/2" x 47-1/2" for the outer border on the top and bottom of the quilt. Stitch, press toward the border.
5. Sew a Black Daisy Baskets 6-1/2" x 57-1/2" LOF strip to each side edge of the quilt center. Press toward the border.
6. Sew a Black Daisy Baskets 6-1/2" x 42" WOF strip end to end to a 6-1/2" x 27" WOF strip; press. Then trim to 60-1/2" length and sew to the top of the quilt. Press toward the border strip. Sew the two remaining strips together; trim and sew to the bottom of the quilt; press.
7. Your quilt is now ready to baste, quilt as desired and bind using the 2-1/2" strips you previously cut.

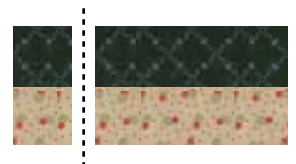
