## Finshed Quilt Size: 42" x 47"

Be sure to read through instructions before beginning. Cutting instructions include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Yardage is based on 42 " of usable fabric width. All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) unless otherwise stated. Press all seams as you assemble your blocks. Border lengths given are exact measure ments. You may want to cut borders slightly longer to allow for variations in seams and mitering corners.

Layout 9 rows of 17 triangles each. Follow order below and refer to photo for fabric placement. Sew triangles together to make row.


Row 1: Utensils/Yellow Wedge Geo B,C,A; Green Wedge Geo/Ric Rac A,C,B; Vegetable Garden/Yellow Wedge Geo B,C,A; Yellow Wedge Geo/Quatrefoil A,C,B; Vegetable Garden/Yellow Wedge Geo B,C,A; Fruit Slices/ Green Wedge Geo A,C.

Row 2: Utensils/Yellow Wedge Geo A,C,B; Fruit Slices/ Utensils B,C,A; Vegetable Garden/Yellow Wedge Geo A,C,B; Ric Rac/Utensils B,C,A; Vegetable Garden/Yellow Wedge Geo A,C,B; Ric Rac/Green Wedge Geo B,C.

Row 3: Yellow Wedge Geo/Ric Rac B,C,A; Fruit Slices/ Utensils A,C,B; Utensils/Fruit Slices B,C,A; Ric Rac/ Utensils A, C,B; Utensils/Green Wedge Geo B, C,A; Ric Rac/Green Wedge Geo A,C.

Row 4: Yellow Wedge Geo/Ric Rac A, C,B; Vegetable Garden/Quatrefoil B,C,A; Utensils/Fruit Slices A,C,B; Fruit Slices/Yellow Wedge Geo B,C,A; Utensils/Green Wedge Geo A,C,B; Fruit Slices/Yellow Wedge Geo B,C.

Row 5: Ric Rac/Yellow Wedge Geo B,C,A; Vegetable Garden/Quatrefoil A,C,B; Green Wedge Geo/Fruit Slices B,C,A; Fruit Slices/Yellow Wedge Geo A,C,B; Vegetable Garden/Green Wedge Geo B,C,A; Fruit Slices/Yellow Wedge Geo A,C.

Row 6: Ric Rac/Yellow Wedge Geo A,C,B; Yellow Wedge Geo/Fruit Slices B,C,A; Green Wedge Geo/Fruit Slices A,C,B; Utensils/Ric Rac B,C,A; Vegetable Garden/Green Wedge Geo A,C,B; Green Wedge Geo/Ric Rac B,C

Row 7: Vegetable Garden/Green Wedge Geo B,C,A; Yellow Wedge Geo/Fruit Slices A,C,B; Vegetable Garden/ Yellow Wedge Geo B,C,A; Utensils/Ric Rac A,C,B; Ric Rac/Yellow Wedge Geo B,C,A; Green Wedge Geo/Ric Rac A,C.

Row 8: Vegetable Garden/Green Wedge Geo A,C,B; Utensils/Green Wedge Geo B,C,A; Vegetable Garden/ Yellow Wedge Geo A,C,B; Green Wedge Geo/ Fruit Slices B,C,A; Ric Rac/Yellow Wedge Geo A,C,B; Yellow Wedge Geo/Quatrefoil B,C.

Row 9: Fruit Slices/Yellow Wedge Geo B,C,A; Utensils/ Green Wedge Geo A,C,B; Ric Rac/Green Wedge Geo B,C,A; Green Wedge Geo/Fruit Slices A,C,B; Vegetable Garden/Utensils B,C,A; Yellow Wedge Geo/Quatrefoil A,C.

Align two rows at a time, matching hexagon centers. Sew rows together. Trim off extra triangle edges on right and left sides of quilt center.

Trace 3 templates Each with one colored line.

Triangle with green line is Template A. Triangle with blue line is Template B. Triangle with red line is Template C.

Align colored line on seam of 2 print strips. Be sure print noted as "base" is in the section of the template marked.

## Borders

Sew (2) 1 1/2" Wedge Geo strips together. Sew strip to the right side of quilt. Trim strips even with quilt. Sew remaining piece of strip to (1) 1 1/2" Green Wedge Geo strip. Sew strip to left side of quilt and trim.

Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Wedge Geo strip to top and (1) to the bottom of quilt center. Trim emds even with quilt sides.

## Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting and backing piece, wrong sides of fabric both toward batting and baste. Hand quilt, machine quilt or tie as desired. Sew binding strips together into one continuous strip, iron in half lengthwise and sew to raw edge of quilt top. Fold in and overlap end of binding. Turn over raw edge and hand stitch to back of quilt.
