Starry Path

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 1 - 9 1/4" x 9 1/4" square, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 4 triangles ☒
cut 1 - 3" strip, then subcut 4 - 3" x 3" squares and subcut 4 - 3" x 3 1/2"

Fabric B - cut 2 - 9 1/4" x 9 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 8 triangles ☒
center star - cut 8 - 2" squares and 1 - 3 1/2" square
1st Border - cut 4 - 2 1/2" strips, then subcut:
2 - 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 - 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

Outer Border - cut 4 - 2 1/2" x 40 1/2"

Fabric C - stars - cut 1 - 3 1/2" strip, subcut 4 - 3 1/2" squares
cut 2 - 2" strips, subcut 32 - 2" squares
cut 4 - 5 1/2" strips, subcut 28 - 5 1/2" squares

Fabric D - cut 2 - 3" strips, subcut 16 - 3" x 3" squares
cut 2 - 3" strips, subcut 16 - 3" x 3 1/2" rectangles
cut 1 - 9 1/4" x 9 1/4" square, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 4 triangles ☒

Fabric E - Borders - cut 8 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end for one long strip then subcut:

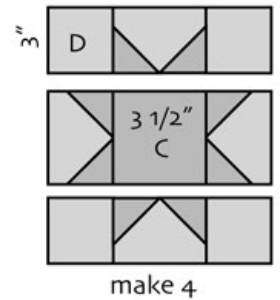
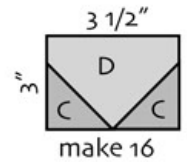
1st border - cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 24 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

Outer border - cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" (SIDES) and 2 - 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" (TOP and BOTTOM)

Fabric F - a - cut 3 - 3" strips, subcut 28 - 3" squares
b - cut 3 - 4" strips, subcut 28 - 4" squares
cut 4 - 2 1/2" corner squares (borders)

Fabric G - BINDING - cut 5 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

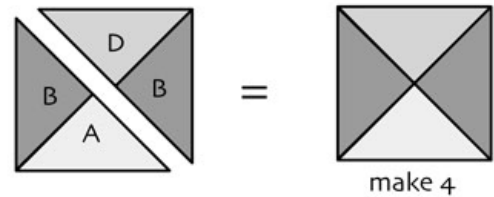
2. Make 4 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unfin.) star blocks. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of 32 **C** 2" squares. Repeat same sew 'n flip method with **C** 2" squares and **D** 3" x 3 1/2" rectangles for 16 star tip units.



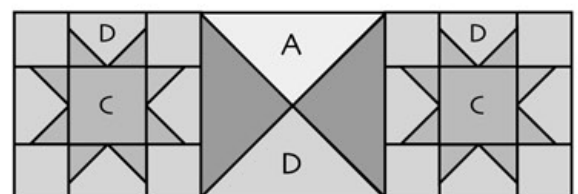
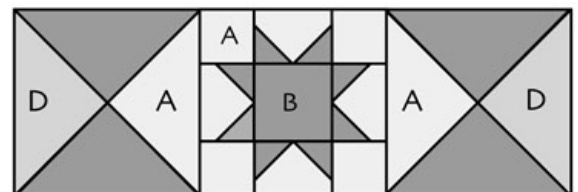
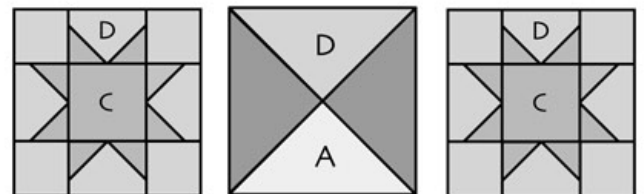
Sew stars together by rows:

3. Make 4 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unfin.) Quarter Square Triangle blocks. Sew 4 pairs of **B/A** triangles and 4 pairs of **B/D** triangles.

Press toward **B** triangles. Then connect pairs for 4 blocks according to the diagram.



4. Sew quilt center together by rows:

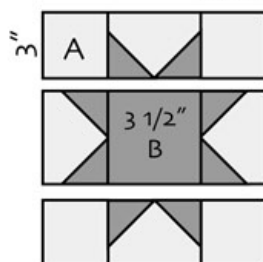


2. Piecing Order:

1. Make 1 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unfin.) center star. First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 8 **B** 2" squares. Place one **B** square over bottom left corner of **A** 3" x 3 1/2". Stitch ON diagonal line, trim 1/4" from seam and press outward. Place another **B** square over adjacent corner of **A**. Stitch ON the diagonal line, trim 1/4" from seam and press outward. Make 4 star tip units.

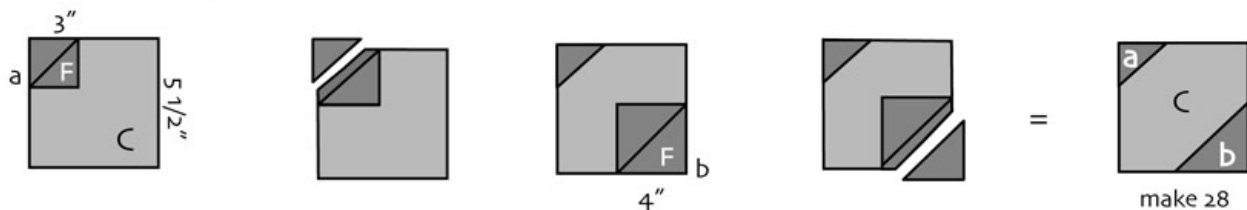


Next, sew center star together by rows according to the diagram:



5. Sew individual **E** and **B** borders around center square, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram.

6. Make 28 - 5" finished (5 1/2" unf.) border blocks. First, draw a diagonal line on the backside of 28 **F** 3" squares (**a**) and 28 **F** 4" squares (**b**). Place one **a** square over corner of **C** 5 1/2" square, right sides together. Stitch ON the diagonal line, trim 1/4" from seam. Press half of the blocks toward **C** and press half outward. Next, place one **b** square over the opposite corner of **C** squares, right sides together. Stitch ON the diagonal line, trim 1/4" from seam. Press half of the blocks toward **C** and press half outward.



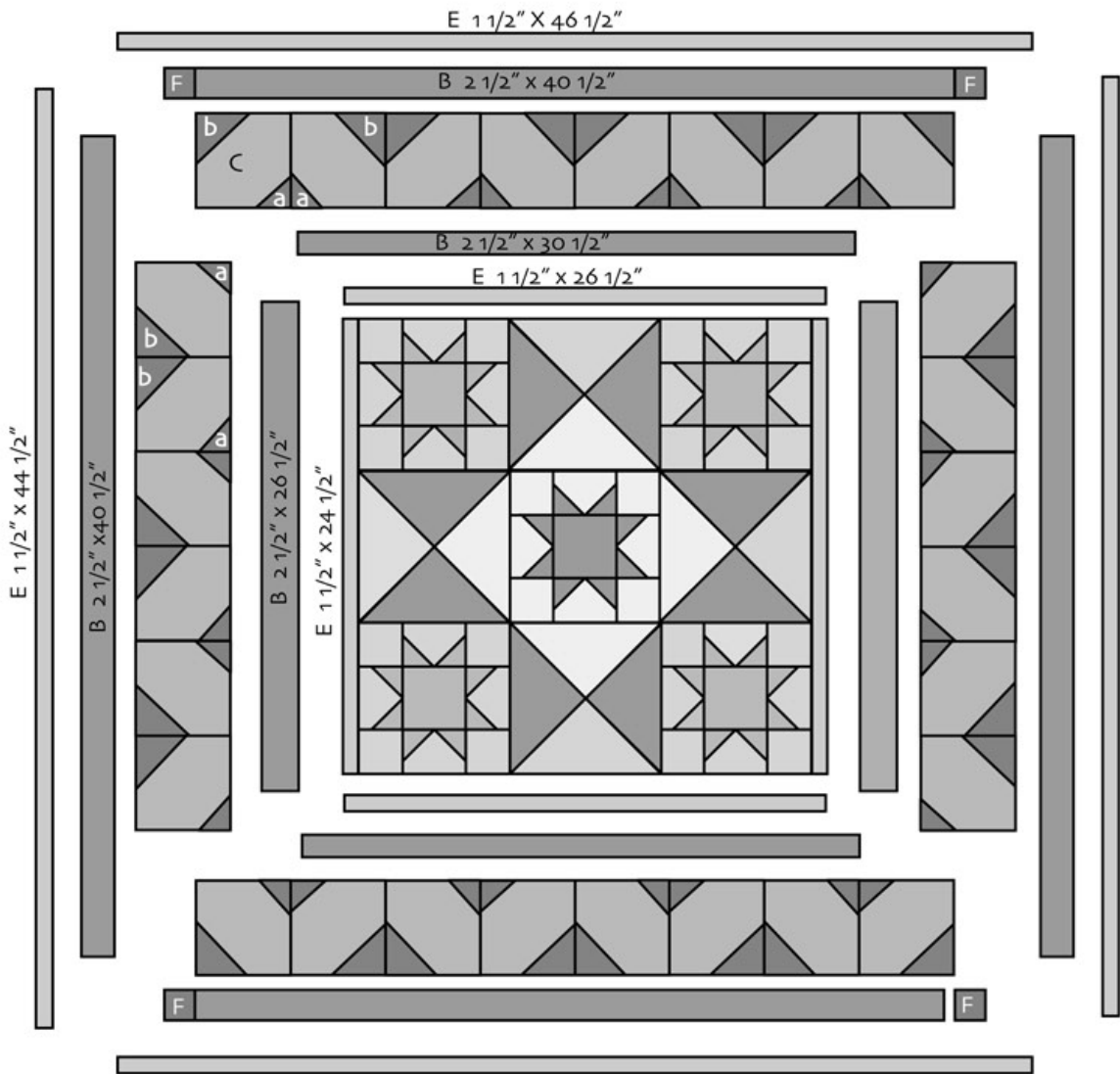
7. Sew 6 border blocks together for both **SIDE** borders and sew 8 blocks together for the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram.

Alternate blocks with opposite pressing directions for less bulk and finer points. Sew **SIDE** borders to the quilt, then sew **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

8. Next, sew **F** 2 1/2" squares to both ends of **B** **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

Sew **Outer B** border to the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

9. Last, sew **E** borders to the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.



10. The quilt measures approximate 46 1/2" x 46 1/2". Make backing (**Fabric A**) at least 6" larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
