## Quilter Basics

- Please read all instructions before beginning.
- Label your cut pieces
- All instructions use $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
- Press all seams toward dark fabric.
- 22 " measurement is approximate.


## Fabric Requirements

Blocks: 12 assorted fat quarters
Background \& Border: 5 yards
Second Border: $5 / 8$ yard
Final Border: $11 / 2$ yards
Binding: $7 / 8$ yard
Backing: 5 yards

## Cutting:

Hint: Heavily spray starch the fat quarters and Background before cutting. This will make the fabric more stable when working with the $60^{\circ}$ angles.

## Blocks:

from EACH of 12 fat quarters cut:
$3-5 " \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips
subcut $9-5 " \times 5$ " squares

## Background and Border:

Be sure to fold the fabric in half, wrong sides together then cut:
$34-41 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips subcut $200-41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## $7-2$ "x WOF strips

## Second Border:

## 8-2"x WOF strips

Final Border:
9-51/2"x WOF strips
Binding: 9-21/2"x WOF strips

## Construction

1
Triangles: Make sure $2-41 / 2 " \times 6$ rectangles are layered wrong sides together (WST). Place the $60^{\circ}$ ruler on the rectangles, aligning the $6^{\prime \prime}$ horizontal line on the ruler with the bottom of the rectangles and the left hand vertical line with the left edges. Cut. Rotate the remaining fabric and repeat. This will make 2 -left facing and 2 -right facing triangles. Repeat with the remaining 99 rectangle pairs to make a total of 200 -right facing and 200-left facing triangles.


Repeat to make a total of 200-right facing and 200-left facing triangles.

2Block A: Select $1-5$ "x 5 " block square and 4 -right facing triangles $\checkmark$
(A) Align a triangle WS up on the square, offseting $7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$. Sew using a $1 / 4 / 1$ seam. Press away from the square. Trim even to the square.
(B) Align a triangle WS up on the square, offseting $7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$. Sew, press \& trim.
(C) Align a triangle WS up on the square, offseting ${ }^{1 / 4} "$. Sew $\&$ press.
(D) Align a triangle WS up on the square, offseting $1 /{ }^{1 / 2}$. Sew \& press.
(E) Align $1 / 4 /$ line of the ruler as shown, cut. Rotate the block a quarter turn, align the $1 / 4$ " line, cut. Repeat with the remaining 2 sides to cut a $63 / 4$ " square. Make 49 of Block A.


Block A Make 49
$633 / 4 \times 63 / 4$ " with seams Sew, press \& trim. (C) Align a triangle WS up on the square, offseting $1 / 4 "$. Sew $\&$ press. (D) Align a triangle WS up on the square, offseting $1 / 4 "$. Sew \& press. (E) Align $1 / 4$ " line of the ruler as shown, cut. Rotate the block, align the $1 / 4$ " line, cut. Repeat with the remaining 2 sides to cut a $63 / 4$ " square. Make 50 of Block B.

## Assemble Quilt

Using 49 of Block A \& 50 of Block B:
make one Row A using 4-Block A \& 5-Block B. Press in one direction. Make 6 of Row A.
Make one Row B using 5-Block A \& 4-Block B. Press in one direction. Make 5 of Row B.

## Borders

0
Sew the 2"xWOF Background strips together using a bias seam. Add the side borders first then the top and bottom.
Measure across the center of the quilt for the best measurements for the lengths of the borders. Repeat steps to add the 2"x WOF Second Border strips and the $51 / 21 \mathrm{xWOF}$ Final border strips

Join the 9 binding strips together end to end using a bias seam. Press seam open.
Fold binding in half wrong sides together. Press. Layer, quilt and bind the quilt. ENJOY!
