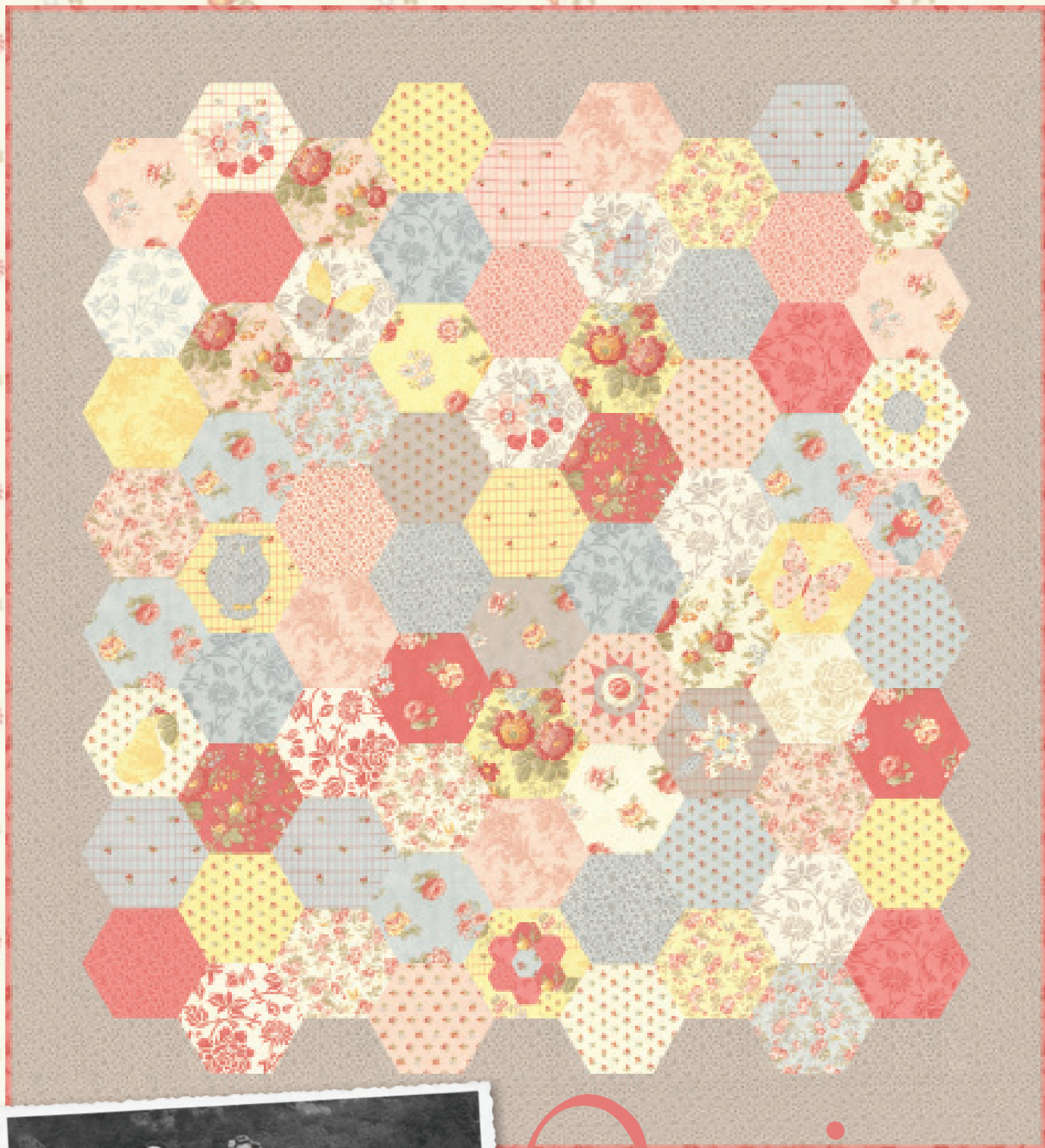

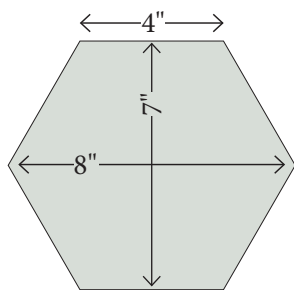

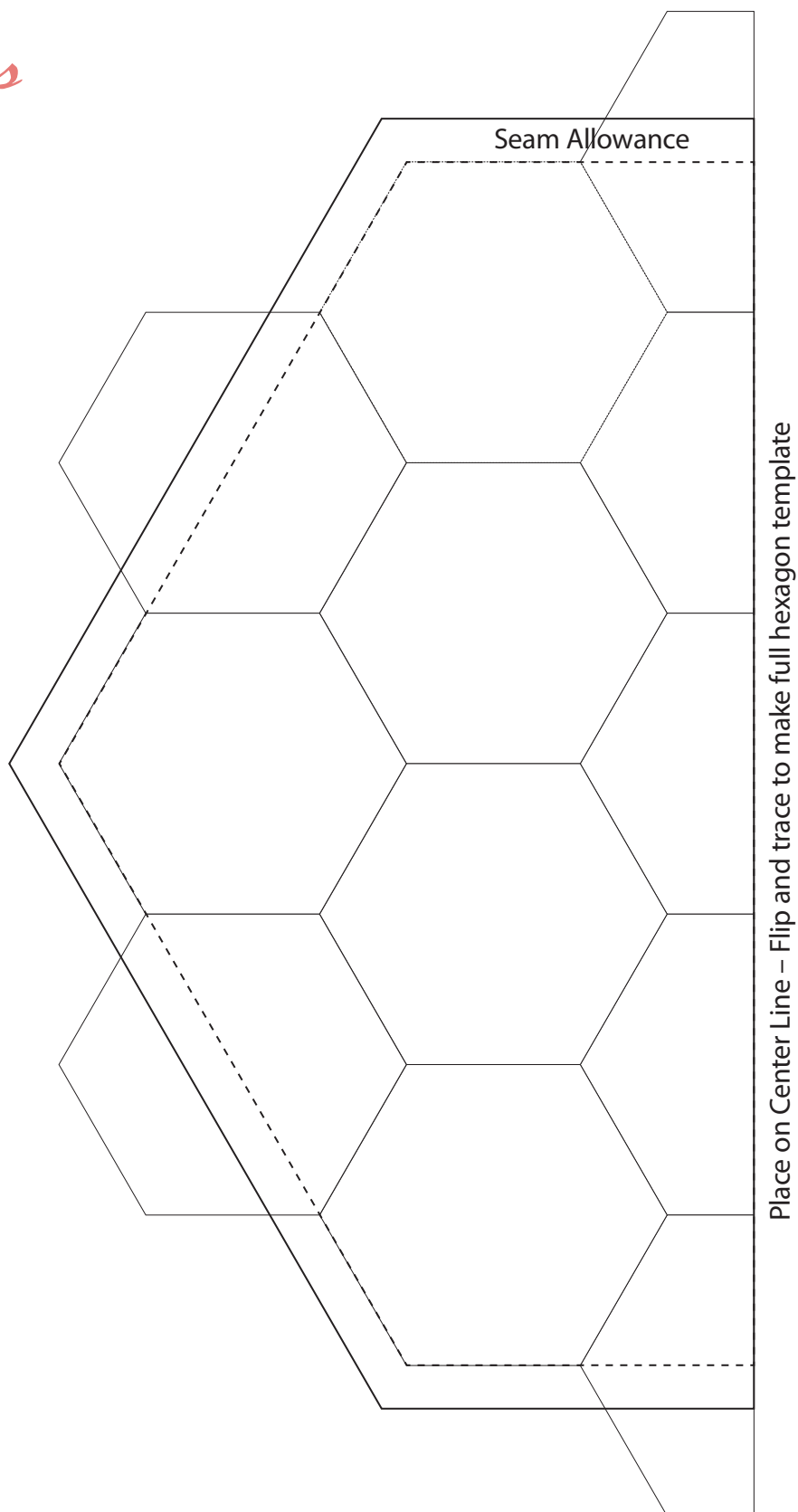


Note: These are the finished measurements of the large hexagon. The hexagon is wider than it is tall.

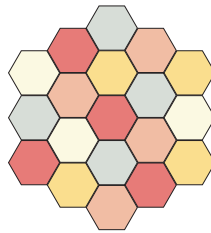
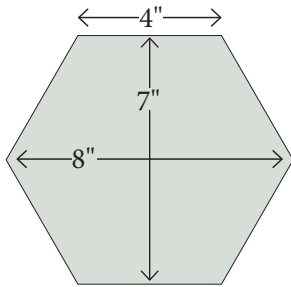
Quilter Basics

Read instructions before beginning a project • All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance • 22" measurement is approximate • WOF—approximately 40".

Quilt Construction

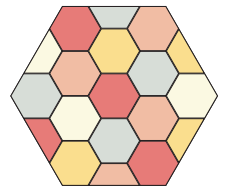
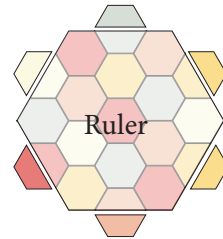
- 1 Mini Hexagons:** Make mini hexagons using the mini charm packs and paper pieces. Make 57 small hexagons. Follow the instructions included in the paper piece packet to assemble the hexagons. Use the ruler to trim 2 of the hexagons to the correct size.

Note: These are the finished measurements of the large hexagon. The hexagon is wider than it is tall.



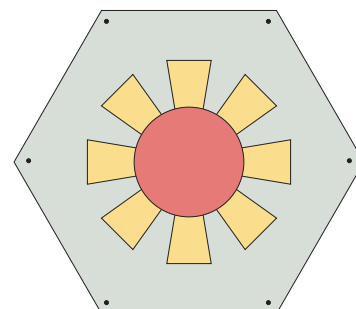
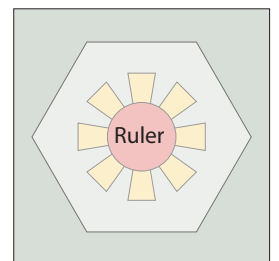
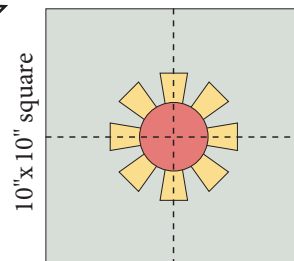
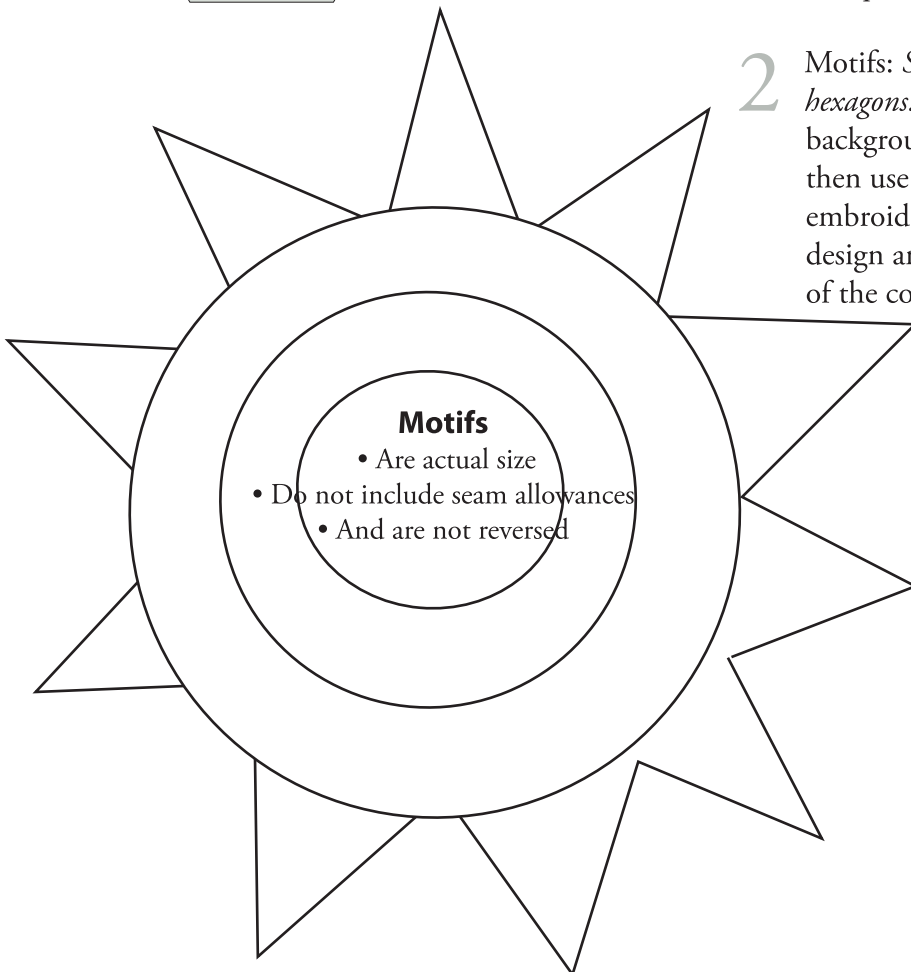
3 Pieced Hexagons

Set aside one to appliqué to the quilt top



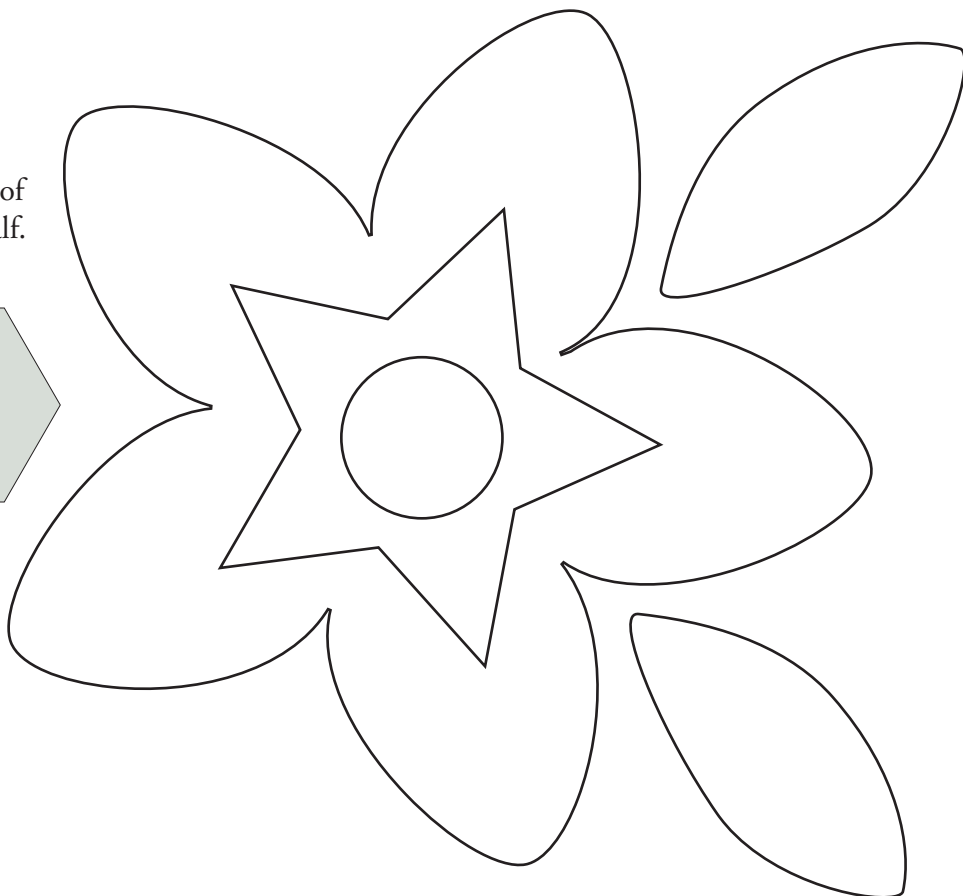
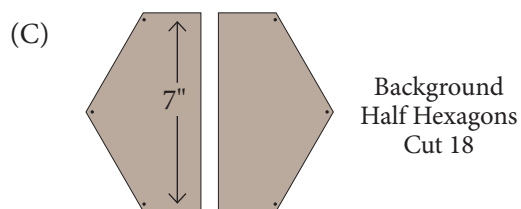
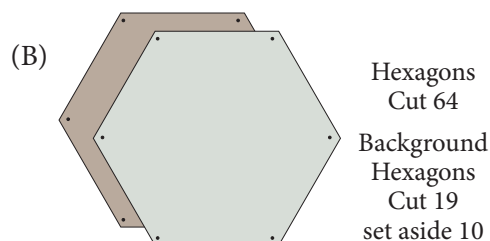
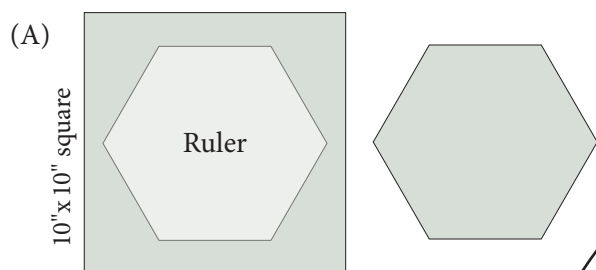
Pieced Hexagons
Make 2

- 2 Motifs:** Set aside 64 Layer Cake™ square for the large hexagons. Use remaining Layer Cakes™ for appliqué backgrounds. Find the center of a Layer Cake™ square then use your method of choice to either appliqué or embroider the design. Center the Hexagon Ruler over the design and cutout. Mark ¼" away from the edge at each of the corners.



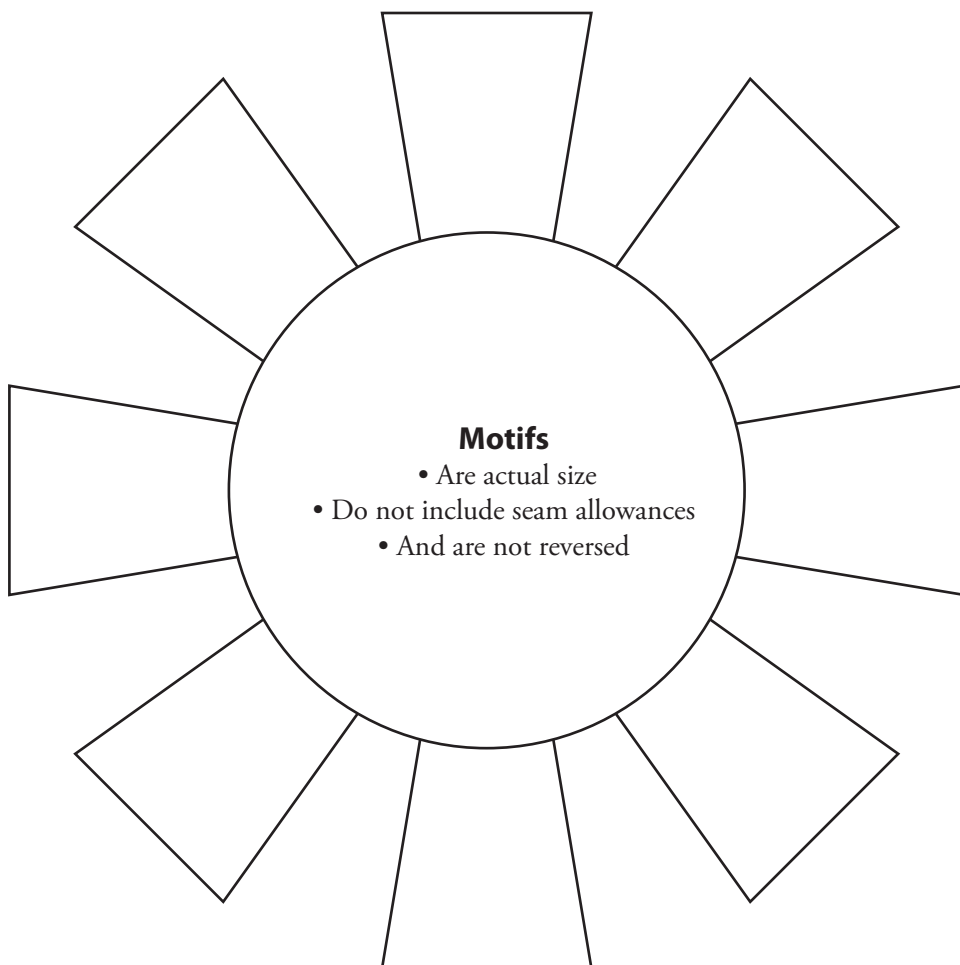
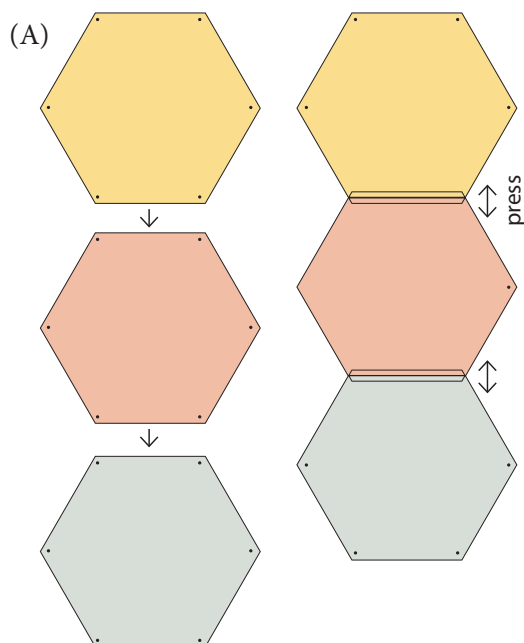
Hexagons with Motifs
Make 12

- 3 Hexagons: (A) Cut the largest hexagon from 64 assorted and 19 Background squares using the Hexagon Ruler.
- (B) Mark $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the edge at each of the corners. (C) Cut 9 Backgrounds in half.

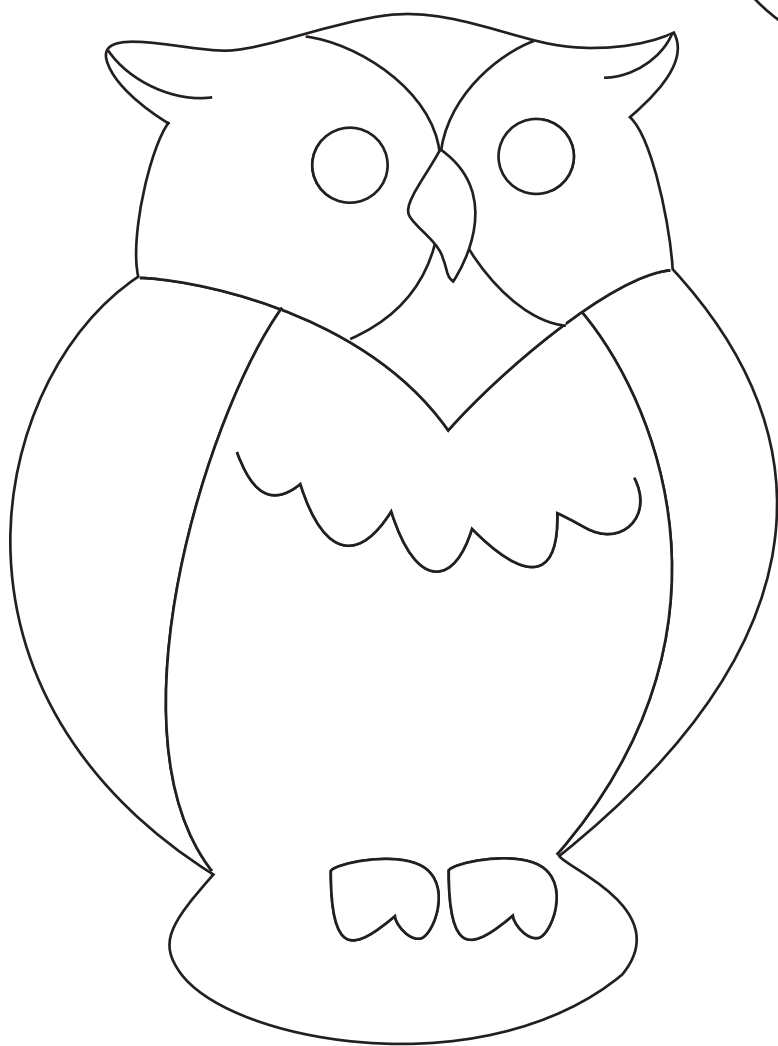
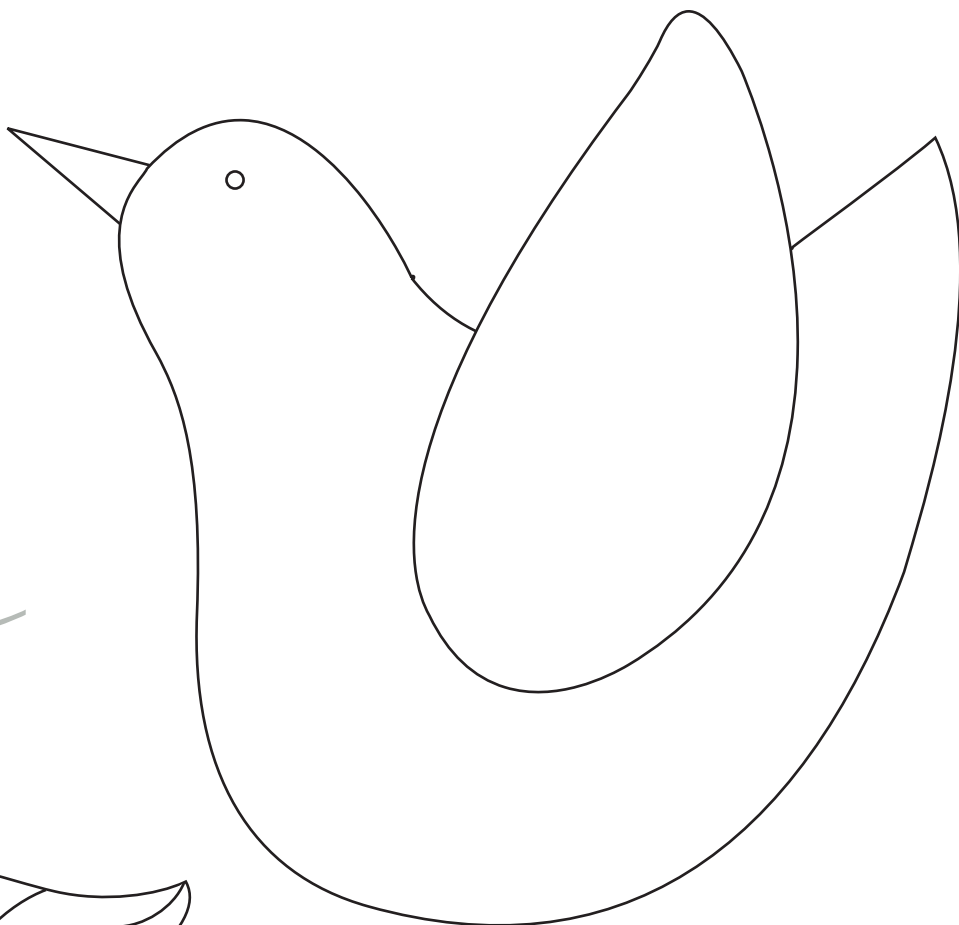

- 4 How to sew the blocks together:
- (A) First sew the hexagons in rows. Press the seams open.



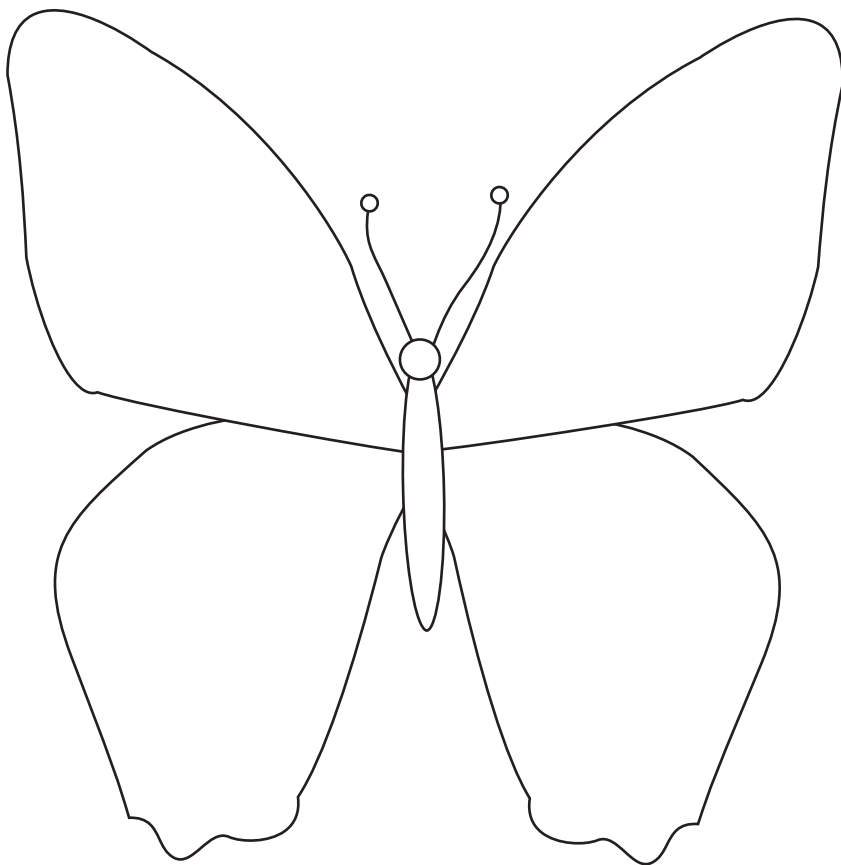

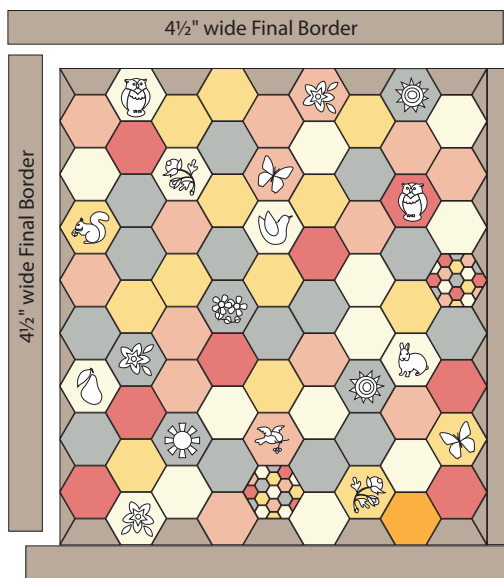
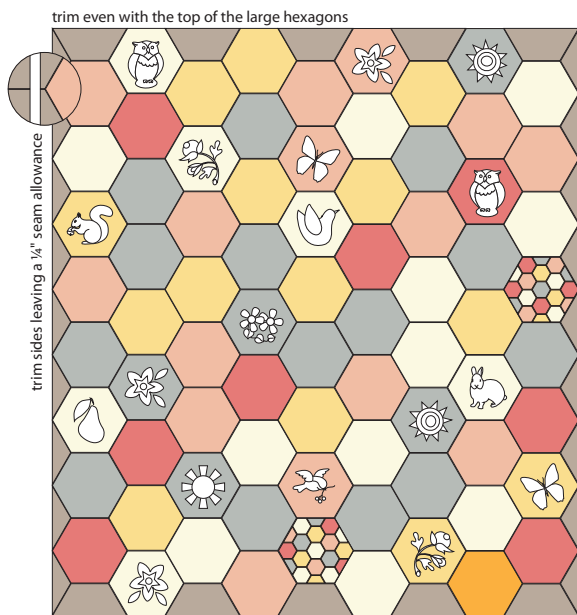


5 Join the large hexagons by machine. The $\frac{1}{4}$ " marked spots are your stopping and starting points when sewing. (A) Line up 2 hexagons, sew in a few stitches from the marked spot, then backstitch to hold this seam in place being careful not to sew into the $\frac{1}{4}$ " opening. Sew to the next marked spot (B) then backstitch. Align the sides of the hexagons then begin sewing at marked spot.

Note: This step becomes easier and easier with practice. However, it does become cumbersome to handle as the quilt top gets larger. Pressing and lightly starching as you go makes the top more manageable.

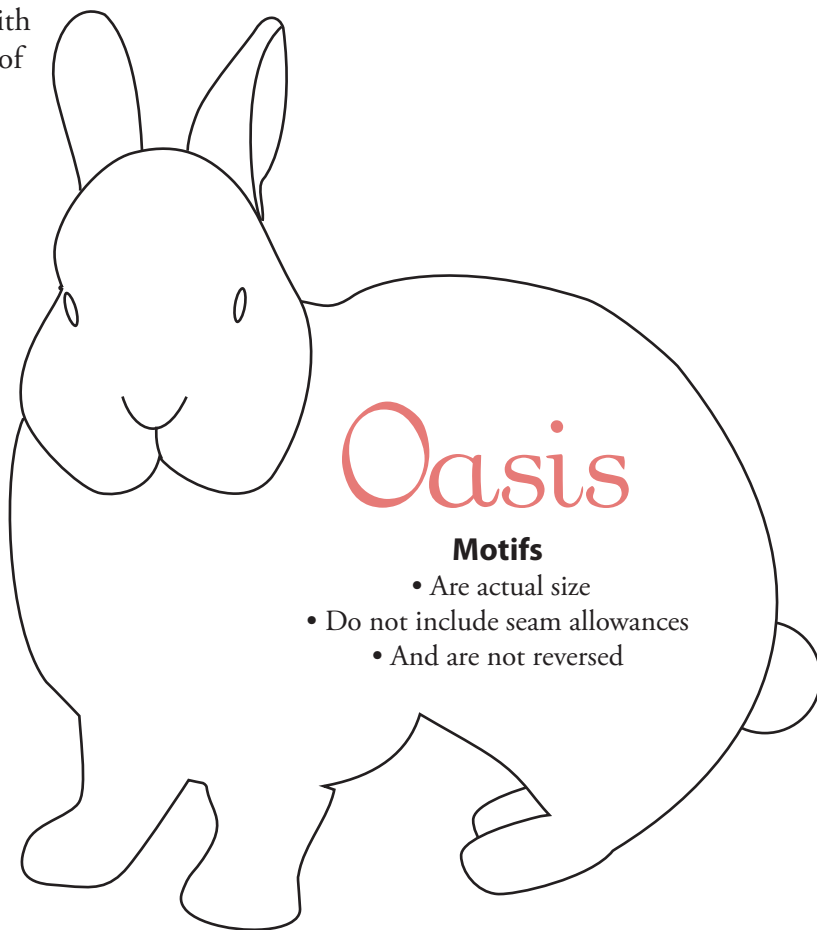


- 6 Trim the top and bottom of the quilt even with the top of the large hexagons. Trim the sides of the quilt leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.



- 7 Add the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " wide Final Borders, sides first then the top and bottom. Measure across the center of the quilt for the best measurement for the border lengths.

- 8 Join the $9-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the Binding. Layer, quilt and bind the quilt. ENJOY!



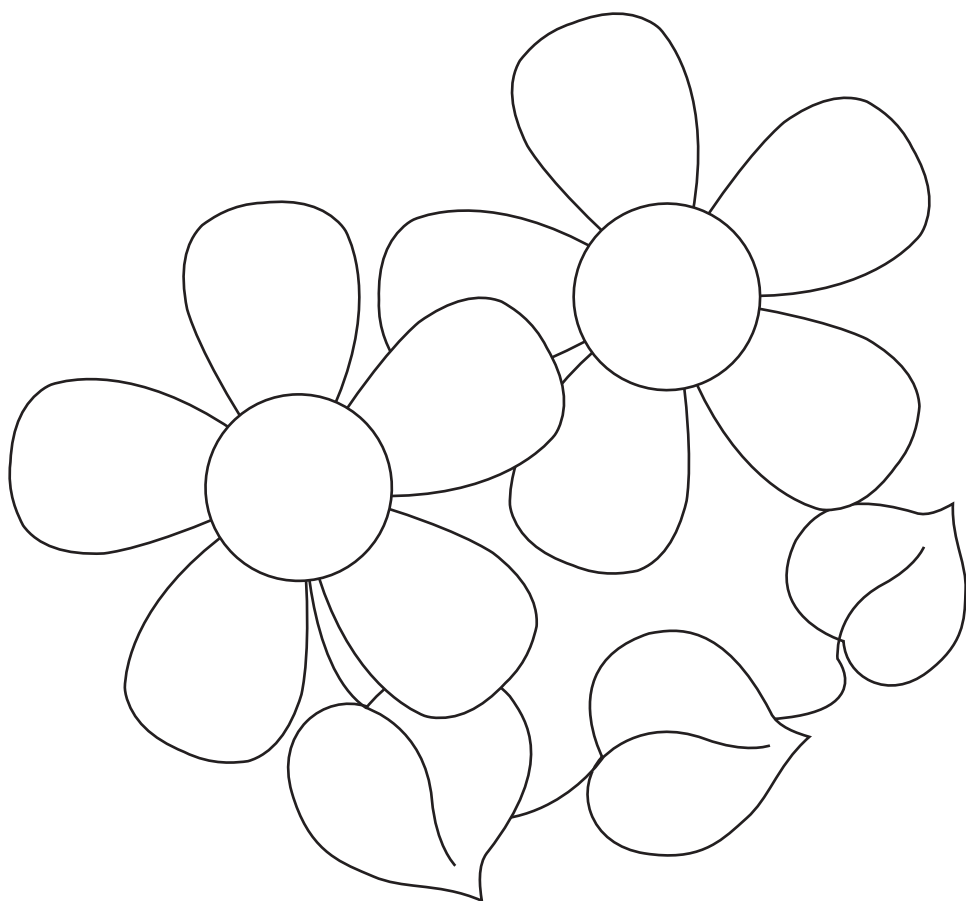

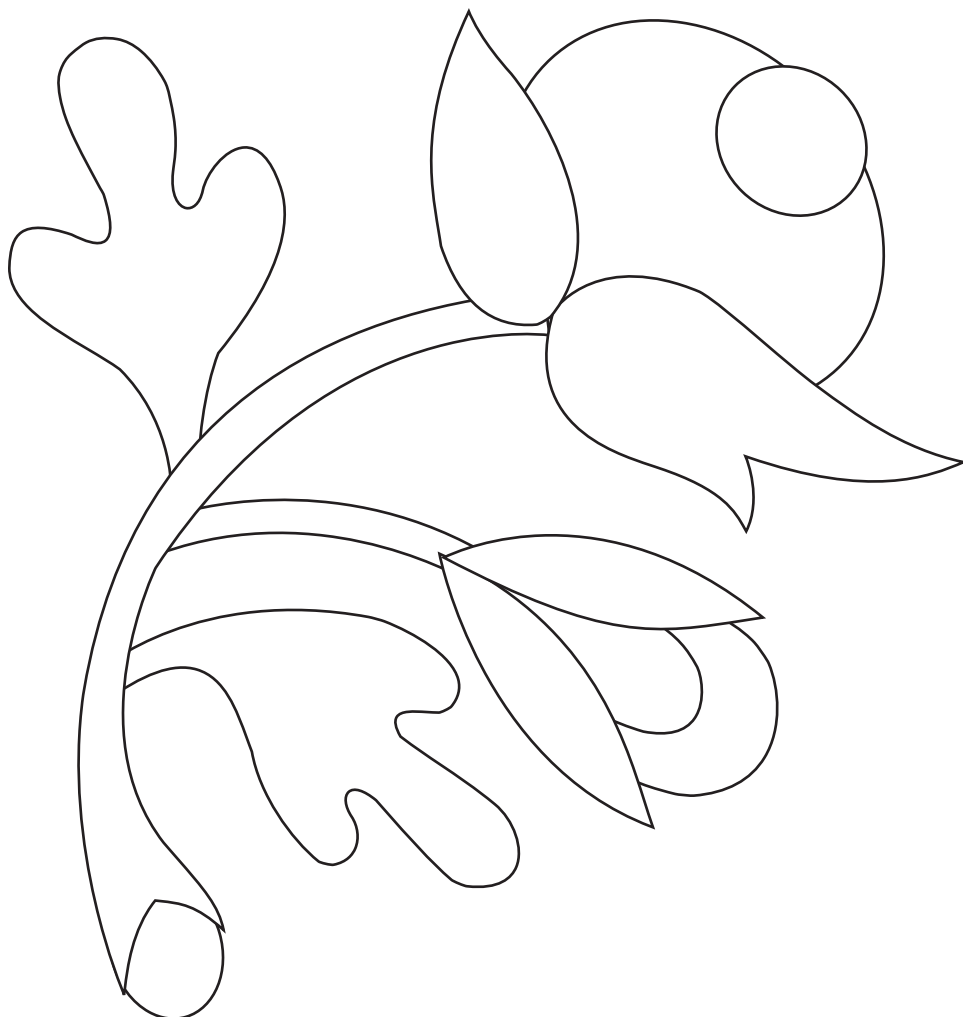

Fabric Requirements

Hexagons: 2 Layer Cakes™ (4040LC)

Small Hexagons & Motifs: 2 Mini Charm Packs™ (if using Kit4040) or 1 Charm Pack(4040PP)

Background, Final Border & Binding: 3½ yards (4048 16)

Backing: 5½ yards

My Favorite Hexagon Ruler (#8060 Michell Marketing)

1" Hexagon Paper Pieces (HEX100)

Assorted threads for embroidery & appliqué

Fabric Cutting

Background, Final Border & Binding:

5–10"x WOF strips

then cut 19–10"x10" for hexagons

9–4½"x WOF strips for borders

9–2½"x WOF strips for binding
